

Western Family & Consumer Sciences Show

Objective: To provide an opportunity for youth and adults to participate in various contests in the Family and Consumer Sciences areas in conjunction with the Western Junior Livestock Show. The show is over 50 years old and is organized by a show board consisting of volunteers from the area.

- Participants are eligible to participate from any county, state or country
- All participants are encouraged to buy a \$5 membership during the show. The money is used for awards and the expenses of the yearly show.
- **Your age on October 7, 2022 determines your division, Cloverbud: 5 to 8; Beginner: 8 to 10; Junior: 11 to 13; Senior: 14 to 18; Adult: 19 to ?**
- Pre registration is not necessary. Try to come to the contests at least 30 minutes before the end of the contest. Most important is to Come and Have Fun.
- Youth and Adults may enter as many contests as they wish but must follow the guidelines for each contest.
- Results will be posted in the Walter Taylor Building as soon as available.
- All exhibits must be picked up on Saturday following the Awards program. Individual contest papers are available in county packets. County offices need to make arrangements to have their packets picked up or the individual papers will be disposed of on Monday morning following the show. Please designate someone from each county to pick up awards that may have been won by members. Papers may be picked up from contest areas 1 hour after completion.
- Ribbon placing will be given in all contests except the cookie decorating which will be a non - competitive "for fun" contest.
- Top prizes will be presented during the Awards Program at 3 PM on Saturday in the Walter Taylor Building.
- Educational Trips may be awarded as determined by the Show Board. Seniors only can win a trip to Denver in January. You must have participated in three FCS shows including the current year to be eligible for this trip. - Regular 4-H judging class cards will be used
- Teams will be picked from the top three scores from each county in beginner, junior and senior divisions
 - Written reasons will be given for at least one class

Family Life Photo Contest

- Photo **MUST** represent **Family Life**. Photos will be judged on the following areas: Storytelling, composition, photographic quality, mounting and neatness
- Enter only one photo, not a group of photos. It can be color, black and white, or a digital print
 - Entrants are encouraged to be original and show creativity in the photos
 - **Mount 8x10 photo on 11x14 board (horizontal or vertical)**
- Exhibitor's name and county should be written on the back of the board and tag for front will be available at time of contest
 - Photos will be judged in order they are entered and can be interview judged
 - Entries should be picked up on Saturday after the awards program

Meat Identification and Judging Contest

- Contest consists of identifying the species, primal cut, retail name and cooking method
 - Each age group identifies a different number of cuts
 - Scorecard is determined by contest coordinator and the show board
 - Awards will be given in each division

Clothing Construction

- Constructed-a complete outfit with all garments constructed by the participant unless considered an accessory
 - Constructed/ Purchased (Sew and Buy): A complete outfit consisting of at least one garment constructed by the participant with the remaining garments purchased or constructed by someone other than the participant
 - Purchased: A complete outfit purchased by the participant
- Participants may exhibit in more than one category but only one outfit in each category

Any Other Sewn Items

- Any item under 40" square. Examples: pillowcase, doll clothes, table runner, pillow
 - Any other sewn item over 48" square. Example: quilt, throw
- Entries may have been judged in another event such as the county fair or Make it Yourself With Wool contest but a change in accessories or garment should be made
 - Please bring a picture and brief description or script the day of the contest
- *Participants are encouraged to participate in the Fashion Show on Saturday at 3:00 pm*

Home Living Contest

Friday 12:00 noon-6:00 pm, Walter Taylor Building

Cloverbud, Beginner, Junior, Senior

- Contestants can bring their completed table (can be one-sided) arrangement or wall decoration or may make it at the show
 - The entry can be made of any materials
 - Only one entry per exhibitor and must be the work of the entrant.
 - Mats or other base accessories that enhance the arrangement are encouraged
 - Entries will be interview judged
- Judging will be based on the following criteria: Proportion and balance, originality and creativity, color harmony, combination of materials, quality and condition and how the participant answers the questions. Participants should know the cost of the entry and how it was constructed
 - Exhibits should be picked up on Saturday after the awards program

Produce Identification and Judging Contest

Cloverbuds, Beginner, Junior, Senior, Adult

- Contestants will identify produce varieties (15 for Beginners and Juniors and 25 for Seniors and Adults and judge 4 classes of produce with the possibility of two classes having check off reasons
 - No communication is allowed during the contest
- County teams will be picked from the top three scores from each county in beginner, junior and senior divisions
 - Please do not touch the items so each contestant sees the display the same way
 - Regular 4-H judging cards will be used

Ingredient Measuring Contest

*Friday, 12:00 noon-6:00 pm, Saturday, 8:00 am-12:00 noon, Fine Arts Building
Cloverbud, Beginner*

- All equipment for this contest will be provided
- Contestants will measure three different food products
- Contestants will draw a set of measuring instructions, select the utensils and measure
 - They have 10 minutes to complete the task and visit with the judge
- Contestants should know the measuring utensils, correct measuring methods as well as measuring equivalents such as 3t= 1 T, 2 cups=1 pint
- Judging will be based on measuring skills and work habits

Lego Contest

Contestants must check in at Lego registration table

All lego pieces are provided by the FCS Show

- Beginners and Juniors will receive the Basic Lego Bricks and Technic Pieces.
Cloverbuds will have Basic Bricks
 - Each contestant will draw out their "Theme Challenge" from the mystery box
 - Once the contestant has their "Theme", they will proceed to the building area
 - All contestants will be timed individually, with a **20 minute** time limit
 - Only contestants will be allowed in the Lego Building area.
- Parents, Friends and Siblings must remain out of the Judging area so contestants are not distracted.*
- Contestants will be judged on: Use of time, Creativity, Best use of Legos provided and Ability to explain what they built
 - When the timer "DINGS", the contestants must stop building and proceed to the judging area
 - Following the judging, the contestant's creations will be photographed with ribbon placing and displayed digitally on computer in the Walter Taylor Building following the close of the contest on Saturday
 - After creation photos are taken, the Lego creations must be taken to the disinfecting table by the contestant to be disassembled in order to recycle for the next contestants

Family and Consumer Sciences Skill-A-Thon

- The contest will cover the areas of Clothing and Textiles, Foods and Nutrition, Home Living and Child Development. It will also have a judging class with written reasons.
 - Beginners and Juniors will have items listed to select from
 - Overall general knowledge of family and consumer science will be helpful
 - The contest will vary each year at the discretion of the contest coordinator

Place Setting Contest

- Cloverbuds will use materials provided by the show, leave their exhibits up until Saturday and receive a participation ribbon.
 - Contest consists of participant displaying a place setting that coordinates with a menu they planned. All dishes, table covering, and centerpieces will be provided by the contestant in the Beginner, Junior and Senior divisions. * Beginners may use the supplies on hand, but need to write a menu at the contest.
 - Contestant will be given a 24x 24 inch exhibit area
- Contestant will be interviewed by the judge in order entered about their place setting, menu and knowledge of nutrition
- Menu should be planned to meet the nutritional needs of the contestant entered in the contest. Menus should be written on a 3x 5 inch or 4 x 6 inch recipe card. Place your name and county on the back of the card. Beginners and Juniors, please plan menu for one meal, Seniors- please plan menu for a day including snacks
 - The SD 4- H Special Foods Handbook is a good resource for this contest
- Judging will be based on the following: Place Setting, appropriate for the menu and correctly set, Centerpiece, original, color, theme and design, menu, balanced and nutritious and age appropriate
 - The show is not responsible for breakage or loss of articles but will strive to have all exhibits remain safe
 - Please pick up your exhibit after the awards program on Saturday

Public Presentation

Beginner, Junior, Senior*

- The presentation can be a demonstration, illustrated talk, speech, project why
 - Presentations maybe a team or individual presentation and maybe given on any area
- The presentation should not have received a blue or purple in another event but maybe an adaptation of another presentation
 - Limit time to 25 minutes or less excluding questions
 - Please leave a clean work area
 - Awards will be given in each age division
- The top Senior award is a educational trip to Denver, Colorado. You must have participated in three FCS Shows including this year to receive this trip

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
