## RESTORED VEHICLE

## **RULES**

- Not State Fair Eligible
- Include an item description on your Fair Entry Form.
- Large vehicles will be displayed outside.

**Restored Vehicle** – scoring: 30pts-General Appearance, 25pts-Written Report, 25pts-Operation, 20pts-Innovation in restoring. A notebook should include:

- 1. Vehicle background and source
- 2. Repairs and parts needed
- 3. Expenses
- 4. Time involved
- 5. Descriptions of special processes used
- 6. Photographs of the item at different stages and youth in action.

**Restoration Display** – detailing a specific process used to restore a vehicle. Examples: painting process, fiberglass repair, window replacement, etc.

**H891003 Bicycle Demonstration Display** – to be exhibited by an individual. Exhibit may include: parts of a bicycle system, worn or broken parts, and a step by step procedure of how some repair or service is performed. A notebook describing what was done and what was learned including photographs should be included. Actual parts or cut-a ways of parts are recommended. The exhibit is to be prepared on a 24" high x 32" wide x \(^1/\_4\)" thick board.

**H891004** Tractor Demonstration Display – to be exhibited by an individual only. Exhibit should show some part or system of a tractor. Include a brief description of how the part or system functions. Prepare the display on a 24" high x 32" wide  $x^{1}/_{4}$ " thick board.
