

## 4-H PERFORMING ARTS CONTEST

### Contest Entries due Monday, July 16

**Number** - All participants must be 4-H members. A 4-H member may perform in one individual and one group class.

**Time** - Each group is allowed two minutes to arrange themselves on the stage and begin performing. Props are not encouraged, but if used, must be in place within the time limit. The performance of each group is limited to six minutes.

**Selection** - Any number of songs may be performed within the six minute time limit. 4-H'ers may perform selections of their choice.

**Accompaniment** - Recorded background music may be used only in Classes B901, B903, B905 and B907. Please bring your own CD player, if recorded accompaniment is used. Other classes may be accompanied by piano, guitar, or other instruments. Live accompaniment, if used, may be by a 4-H member or leader.

**Music Stands** - Please provide your own music stands.

**Director** - Song groups, combos, and bands may appear with or without a director. The director of a group must be a 4-H member.

**Clover Kids** - Clover Kids can participate in the 4-H Performing Arts Contest as long as they are performing as a group along with regular 4-H members.

**State Fair** - There is no State Fair 4-H Performing Arts Contest.

#### Classes:

**B901. Drill Team** - May be a drill, square or folk dance, tap dance, or any routine done as a group. Must have at least three participants.

**B902. Song Group** - Piano, guitar, or other instrument.

**B903. Song Group** - Recorded music for accompaniment.

**B904. Combo or Band** - Group must be three or more with instruments of their choice, including piano. May include vocalists.

**B905. Solo or duet: vocal**

**B906. Solo or duet: instrumental**

**B907. Solo or duet: dance**
