- The scholarship will be paid directly to the educational institution of the student's choice at the beginning of the second term of the recipient's post-secondary education. The 4-H member can attend an accredited two or four year college, university, or technical school.
- The scholarship application must be received by **January 15**th of the current school year and must be accompanied by two (2) letters of recommendation. Otoe County Extension personnel are ineligible to serve as a reference for this scholarship.
- You may generate this application with the computer using the format Times New Roman, size 12. You can also go to oto-eta-unl.edu and click on Otoe County 4-H on the top bar. The link to the scholarship application will be at the top under Otoe County 4-H Foundation. Attachments may be added, which could include your personal resume and/or a copy of your 4-H Achievement Application.
