Celebrating Our Achievements

September is the time to start putting together Achievement Applications. To those of you who have been involved in 4-H for a long time, you may remember them as Career Portfolios or Member Record Books. The Otoe County process is a blend of the traditional Career Portfolio and the current Achievement Application created by Nebraska 4-H.

Although the Career Portfolio is no longer accepted for state-level awards, a similar format is required for county-level awards. In Otoe County, this would be the Entry Sheet (Form 1-2024) and the Activity Sheet (Form 2-2024). These forms are more for record keeping of the activities and projects a 4-H youth has been involved in.

Similar to the state-level Achievement Application, a My Experiences Report is required for county-level awards. This is a written report of the work accomplished. It looks similar to a resume, it is also a story telling of sorts.

These three items come together to complete the Otoe County Achievement Application. We highly encourage all 4-H aged youth to participate in the Achievement Application Process. Reflecting on completed work, celebrating triumphs & struggles, and writing positively about yourself are all skills that youth need to practice.

The information gathered will be used for Senior Recognition at Achievement Night and for creating Senior Banners. In order to receive your banner, you must be re-enrolled in 4-H for the 2023-2024 4-H year.

Nitrate is a valuable fertilizer source that keeps Nebraska growing abundant landscapes and crops. Nitrogen that does not get used by the crop ends up in our streams, lakes and groundwater. Nitrate is the most common form of nitrogen found in water. It has economic, recreation, and health impacts for the residents of Nebraska. (https://water.unl.edu/category/nitrate)
