**STEM:** Aerospace, Clothing & Textiles, Computers, Electricity, Engineering, Photography, Small Engines, Welding, and Woodworking.

**Leadership and Entrepreneurship:** Citizenship, Entrepreneurship, and Leadership.

**Healthy Living:** Food & Nutrition, Health, Home Environment, Human Development, Physical Fitness, and Safety.

**College and Career Preparation for My Future:** Communications.

**Other:** Consumer Management, Heritage, Shooting Sports, and Theatre Arts.

	<b>Outstanding Senior 4-H Member</b> - \$200 cash - 1 award given	Otoe County 4-H Council	Completed 4-H Achievement Application - Must be 14 years or by older by January 1. - Must be a 4-H member for minimum of five years. - 4-H member can win this award only once.
