

OTOE COUNTY AWARDS - due October 1, 2021

County Project Awards - Circle the project(s) listed below to be considered for this county award, which is a medal. The 4-H member can win a project medal **only once during their 4-H career**. The 4-H member needs to be enrolled in the project area for a **minimum of two (2) years** before can they apply.

Agriculture: Beef, Conservation, Companion Animal, Crop Production, Dairy, Dog, Entomology, Forestry, Goats (Dairy and/or Meat), Hogs, Horse, Horticulture, Poultry, Rabbit, Range, Sheep, Veterinary Science, and Wildlife.

STEM: Aerospace, Clothing & Textiles, Computers, Electricity, Engineering, Photography, Small Engines, Shooting Sports, Welding, and Woodworking.

Leadership and Entrepreneurship: Citizenship, Communications, Entrepreneurship, Leadership, and Theatre Arts.

Healthy Living: Consumer Management, Food & Nutrition, Health, Heritage, Home Environment, Human Development, Physical Fitness, and Safety.

When completing the 4-H Achievement Application - 4-H Experiences both Part 1 and Part 2, **it is important to discuss your experiences in the project area(s) you have circled above**. If it is relevant, your Leadership Experiences, Community Involvement/Service Learning Experiences, and Career Spark should also include information about the project area(s) you have circled above.

State Level Awards - For those 4-H members ages 15 to 18 wanting to compete at the State Level you will submit your application by October 1 to the Nebraska Extension in Otoe County Office and online by January 15 within one of these five program areas: Agriculture, STEM, Leadership and Entrepreneurship, Healthy Living, and College and Career Preparation for My Future. Extension staff can advise you in this process.
