



2019 Pawnee County 4-H Livestock Checklist

DEADLINES

- February 16th** — Market Beef Weigh-In
- May 1st** - District Horse Show Deadline for Animal ID's, Horse Level Testing and Entries
- June 5th** — Sheep and goat weigh-in and at Fairgrounds – Pavilion 1
- June 14** — All market/breeding sheep, market/breeding meat goats, breeding & feeder calves, bucket calves, swine, rabbits, dairy cattle, dairy & pygmy goats Identifications and Pre-Entry Form due to Extension office
- June 14** — Deadline to complete requirements for Youth for Quality Care of Animals (formerly Quality Assurance)
- June 14 - Horse Level Testing, Id's, and Pre-Entry Forms for County Fair Deadline
- June 14** — 4-H enrollment due online at <https://ne.4honline.com>
- July 29-August 3rd** — Pawnee County Fair
- August 8th** — AKSARBEN entries due — entries due online at <http://aksarbenstockshow.com>
- August 10** — Nebraska State Fair animal entries due online at <http://nebr.fairwire.com> and Youth Dairy Cattle entries due online via the Nebraska State Fair Open Class entry site (website will be posted).



LIVESTOCK ID/OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR SHOWING ONLY AT COUNTY FAIR

If showing at County Fair AND State Fair/ AKSARBEN, follow those requirements instead of these.

Pick up tags and ID Sheets from Extension office (forms are also online at <https://pawnee.unl.edu>). See deadlines above.

MARKET BEEF, FEEDER CALVES

- Tagged with a 4-H ear tag
- Turn in completed Market or Breeding ID Sheet

BREEDING BEEF

- Breeding beef must have tattoo number as their ID
- Turn in completed Breeding ID Sheet

BUCKET CALVES (require a record book)

- Tagged with a herd or 4-H ear tag
- Turn in completed Bucket Calf ID Sheet

SHEEP, MEAT GOATS

- Tagged with a USDA scrapie tag (breeder supplies these)
- Turn in completed Market or Breeding ID Sheet

SWINE

- Tagged with a 4-H ear tag
- Turn in completed Market or Breeding ID card

DAIRY CATTLE, DAIRY GOATS & PYGMY GOATS

- Turn in completed ID Sheet for your species

RABBITS

- Permanent tattoo in left ear
- Turn in completed Rabbit ID Sheet

LIVESTOCK ID/OWNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE FAIR AND/OR AKSARBEN

Pick up tags and DNA envelopes from the Extension office. Youth participating in the State Fair will have until Aug. 10 (state fair deadline) to select whether they are showing their animal in 4-H or FFA. See deadlines above.

MARKET BEEF, SHEEP, SWINE, MEAT GOATS & FEEDER CALVES

- Market beef, swine and feeder calves tagged with an EID tag (swine also need ear notches recorded)
- Market sheep and meat goats use USDA scrapie tag number for ID (breeder supplies these)
- Submit animal information and payment (\$6 per animal) into online AKSARBEN livestock database at www.showstockmgr.com (step-by-step instructions available)
- Submit DNA sample to the Extension office
- Obtain Premise ID from Nebraska Department of Ag and submit it to the Extension office
- Feeder calves — turn in completed Breeding ID Sheet ?

BREEDING BEEF, SHEEP, MEAT GOATS

- Breeding beef must have tattoo as their ID
- Breeding sheep and meat goats use USDA scrapie tag number for ID (breeder supplies these)
- Submit animal information into online AKSARBEN livestock database at www.showstockmgr.com (step-by-step instructions available)

RABBITS

- Nebraska State Fair does not require a separate ID form, however, tattoo must be listed during the online entry process.
