## OPEN TO CURRENT & NEW YOUTH AGES 8-18!

4-H programs are grounded in the belief that kids learn best by doing. Kids complete hands-on projects in areas like science, health, agriculture and civic engagement, in a positive environment where they receive guidance from adult mentors and are encouraged to take on proactive leadership roles.

During meetings, youth will participate in a short 4-H club meeting and complete an activity while their parent or adult family member learns more about the 4-H program.
