Beyond the Traditional Awards requires the youth to complete a 4-H Career Portfolio, 4-H Project Record Book, Resume (youth ages 12 and older), or Story (youth ages 8 to 11) AND a paragraph explaining why they are applying for a traditional award.	
Junior & Senior Outstanding Member <i>Special pin awarded.</i>	Share involvement in 4-H program activities and leadership experiences. Senior – 14 or older. Junior – 11 to 13.
Junior & Senior Outstanding Leadership Award <i>Special pin awarded.</i>	Tell about offices held and leadership activities in the 4-H program. Senior – 14 or older. Junior – 8 to 13.
Junior & Senior Outstanding Citizenship Award <i>Special pin awarded.</i>	Tell about service projects done and/or any other information that displays good citizenship. Senior – 14 or older. Junior – 8 to 13.
Junior & Senior Outstanding Volunteer Award <i>Special pin awarded.</i>	Tell about the number of hours volunteered and the different volunteer service activities you performed. Senior – 14 or older. Junior – 8 to 13.
Junior, Intermediate & Senior Camp Scholarships – \$70	Senior – 14 or older, Intermediate – 11 to 13 & Junior – 8 to 10 (age as of Jan. 1 of the following year). Good for any camp offered from the Eastern Nebraska 4-H Center at Gretna, State 4-H Camp at Halsey, or at the University of Nebraska (including workshops).
Big Red Summer Academic Camp - \$120	Ages 15 to 18. Career exploration camp at the University of Nebraska in June or July.

BEYOND THE TRADITIONAL AWARDS	
Beyond the Traditional Awards requires the youth to complete a 4-H Career Portfolio, 4-H Project Record Book, Resume (youth ages 12 and older), or Story (youth ages 8 to 11) AND a paragraph explaining why they are applying for a non-traditional award.	
Rookie of the Year	4-H'er, 2 years or less. Tell what's special about 4-H this year.
Hard Luck Award	Animal project or an irreplaceable loss. Why was the project hard luck? What did you learn, was it preventable?
Memorable 4-H Experience Award	Choose any area of 4-H and tell why your experience will never be forgotten.
4-H Flop Award	Projects other than livestock/animals. Tell what project flopped or was unsuccessful and why. What did you learn?
