Tickets

Tickets may be picked up at the Extension Office. We encourage each 4-H member to sell tickets ahead of time so we may have a VERY successful carnival and 4-H year. There are 8 twenty-five cent tickets in each book and they sell for \$2.00 per book.

All money and unsold tickets should be turned into the office on or before Friday, March 8.

PLEASE sell tickets ahead of time!

Food

Each 4-H Family is asked to bring the following:

- 1) One pie or cake for the Cake Walk
- 2) One baked/canned/craft item for the Country Store (items other than cakes are helpful) or donate \$20.00

Please DO NOT bring eggs, cream pies or home canned goods for the Country Store. (Think Food Safety)

Booths

EACH CLUB and ALL INDEPENDENT MEMBERS are expected to have booths. Independent members may work together to form a booth. The 4-H Council is asking 4-H clubs to have **two** booths at the carnival to provide variety. **Booths will be set up Thursday evening from 3:30 to 6:00.** We encourage youth to help set up the carnival booths.

However, **all youth must be supervised by a parent or leader during set up.** Please make sure to have arrangements made for your member before sending them to the fair grounds to set up.

The top three club booths will be given awards. Booths are judged on creativity of decorations, use of the theme and safety.

Please keep safety in mind when planning your booth. Do not use regular footballs or basketballs, use a nerf ball instead. Dart throws can be very dangerous, try to plan accordingly for safety.

Please be sure when deciding on how many tickets to charge for your booth and coupons to give out as prizes that it is a right combination so that we will be able to make a profit from the carnival. For example, don't make the booth so easy that if you pay 2 tickets to play the game you are always giving out 2 or 3 coupons for winning. Make games have different levels of difficulty and give out coupons accordingly, i.e. 1 coupon for easy and 3 for hard. If you have questions on how many tickets to charge and how many coupons to give out, please contact Debbie or Connie at the office.

****Club Leaders-the office can provide a list of your members prior to carnival. It is up to you to track club member participation.***

Participation in the 4-H Carnival is **MANDATORY**. It is the rule of the Chase County 4-H Council that any family or club that does not participate with a booth at carnival will have to pay the following fines:
\$50.00 per Independent Family or \$350 per 4-H Club

2019 Chase County 4-H Carnival Club Responsibilities

Country Store:

General Foods Sales (6:45 - 9:15) - Challengers

- Should have at least 2 adults in the Country Store to sell items.
- Responsible for making the drinks & popcorn and for cleaning up the Country Store area following the Carnival.

Ticket Sales:

Shift 1 (6:45 - 8:05) - Spring Creek, Council

Shift 2 (8:00 - 8:55) - Chase County All Stars

- Each shift should have at least 2 adults to handle ticket sales.

Prize Booth:

Shift 1 (6:45 - 8:05) - Silver Spurs

Shift 2 (8:00 - 9:15) - Chase County Clovers, Independents, Council

- Need at least 2-3 people at the prize booth during the 1st shift.
- Need at least 4 people during the 2nd shift.

CLEAN UP
