RE: PERKINS COUNTY FAIR DOG SHOW

The 2024 Perkins County Dog Show will be held **Monday, July 15**, in the Dance Hall Building at the fairgrounds. **Show check-in will be at 12:30 PM with the show starting at 1:00 PM.**

ALL 4-H entries will be made ONLINE (perkins.fairwire.com). Step by step entry instructions were included with the pre-entry packet you received in the mail and are also available on the Perkins County 4-H fair page: <https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/perkins-chase/perkins-county-4-h-fair-page/>
Entries must be complete by NOON, Tuesday, June 25. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. **Vaccination certificates are required** <https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/perkins-chase/SF263-Dog-Vaccination-Certification.pdf>). **Vaccination certificates that were not turned in by June 3 MUST be turned in to the Extension Office by the entry deadline.**

Please consult the fair book (<https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/perkins-chase/perkins-county-4-h-fair-page/>) before you begin the entry process. One entry is allowed per class unless stated otherwise in the fair book. The number of classes that can be exhibited are limited for some divisions.

DRESS CODE-Exhibitors showing beef, dairy, dogs, companion animals, meat goats, sheep, swine, poultry, and rabbits are required to wear an official 4-H T-shirt (any color). If there is no official 4-H T-shirt, exhibitors are required to wear a white shirt (or blouse) with the official 4-H chevron attached. **Long jeans/pants (dark blue) are required for cat, dog and small pet exhibitors.** **While hard soled shoes are not required for the cat, dog and small pet shows, exhibitors are required to wear closed toed shoes with non-slip soles.** No hats, caps or other types of headgear are to be worn in the show ring. Exhibitors shall not display local, county, commercial or other identification while showing their animals-except official 4-H and such identification the show ring may require.

SHOWMANSHIP AGES-Ages for ALL animal projects (cattle, swine, sheep, goats, poultry, rabbits, pets, dog and horse) will be:

- Juniors—(age 8-10 years)
- Intermediates—(age 11-13 years)
- Seniors—(age 14-18 years)
