LUGGAGE COMMITTEE

All members of the **ORANGE COLOR GROUP** need to be at the trip departure location 30 minutes early to help the sponsors attach luggage tags and load luggage prior to our June 4 departure.

Once on the road, the luggage committee will be the first off the bus to unload and set the luggage on the curb for the entire CWF group.

Each morning, plan to be at the bus at least 10 minutes early before loading to check in each piece of luggage and load it onto the bus. If a bag is missing a luggage tag, a sponsor should be notified immediately. This committee needs to work together and everyone should do their part.

- ⇒ Organize the luggage and other travel gear as it is loaded onto the bus each day.
- ⇒ Unload the luggage for each participant to carry at each stopover.
- ⇒ Assist the sponsors as needed in transporting non-luggage items, if needed.
- ⇒ **Reminder—trip participants are responsible for moving their own luggage in and out of the motel at each stop.**

REFRESHMENT COMMITTEE

Two **BLUE COLOR GROUP** members will be designated to bring coolers. Please bring your cooler filled with ice when we depart on June 4. Plan to arrive at the departure location at least 15 minutes early to help the entire CWF group put their 2 beverages per person into the coolers before we depart. CWF trip participants are required to mark all their beverage containers before we meet at the departure site. A Sharpie marker works well for this. There will be several large containers to hold beverages under the bus.

Once on the road, the refreshment committee will work together to empty the coolers each night and coordinate daily for coolers to be refilled with ice each morning prior to bus departure. This requires the refreshment committee to PLAN AHEAD. When emptying the coolers, please find an appropriate location to do this (don't just dump the water anywhere).

Each trip participant is allowed to start the trip with 9 beverages in re-closable containers (6 beverages in the holding container under the bus, 2 for the cooler on the bus and 1 in hand to drink). Additional beverages may be purchased during the trip or drink bottles may be refilled as needed.
