

CWF Trip Committees

Each 4-H'er will choose one Trip Committee to serve on while traveling on the West Central CWF bus trip.

Appreciation Committee (5 members)

1. Write letters on behalf of the entire CWF delegation.
2. Act as the official spokesmen while on the trip.
3. Write thank you notes to appropriate individuals following the trip.

Luggage Committee (ALL)

1. Organize the luggage and other travel gear as it is loaded and unloaded each day from the buses.
2. Unload the luggage for each participant and set on curb site for easy access.

Refreshment Committee (ALL)

1. Arrange for drink coolers to be used on the trip.
2. Committee members will coordinate daily for coolers to be refilled with ice each morning prior to bus departure and emptying coolers at the end of the day.
3. Keep 4-H'er aware of how many drinks they can keep in the cooler at a time.

Travel Environment Committee (ALL)

1. Maintain cleanliness and orderliness of the bus throughout the entire trip.
2. Organize the entire delegation to take part in maintaining a positive and clean environment.

Health & Well Being Committee (5 members)

1. Each committee member will be assigned a date and time to focus on ways to stay positive and healthy while traveling.
2. Committee members will remind fellow trip participants to stay hydrated, eat well, wear sunscreen, etc.
3. Committee members will be prepared to give basic first aid advice (how to treat blisters, sunburn, stomach upset, etc.)
4. Committee members will be responsible for reporting concerns regarding the health of fellow travelers to sponsors.

Daily News Committee (14 members)

1. Obtain a daily newspaper or electronic site and review current events that are happening while we are traveling.
2. Each committee member will be assigned a specific day.

Media Committee (5 members)

1. Members of this committee will write news articles for the local papers at home and have them published for the West Central CWF group.
2. Committee members will obtain several group photos to include with their newspaper article.

Facebook Committee (ALL)

1. Upload brief trip experiences and photos to the trip Facebook site.
2. Each committee will be assigned specific days to post to our Facebook group.
3. Committee members will be responsible for taking and posting official photos of the group.
4. Committee members will arrange for several group photos to be taken throughout the trip.
