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### **4-H Volunteer Screening**

All 4-H volunteers and staff are required to complete the Nebraska 4-H volunteer screening process outlined below. Volunteer screening is done in order to assure a safe, positive, and nurturing environment for all youth involved with the Nebraska 4-H programs and provide protection for the child, the volunteer, the educator, the 4-H Council, the Extension Board, and the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Extension.

The Following 3 steps must be completed by all 4-H volunteers serving as a Direct Volunteer before performing your role. All steps need to be completed prior to your volunteer service.

- 1.) 4-H Online Enrollment: <u>https://v2.4honline.com</u>

- 2.) DHHS Volunteer Screening (must use this link).

  - \$5 Fee associated with screening

3.) Volunteer Orientation

**Direct volunteers** are those working directly with youth, such as club leaders and workshop facilitators. Direct volunteers will be asked to complete the following screening process and repeat screening as scheduled.

Please note that direct volunteers are responsible for covering a screening fee. Currently, the cost of the screening is \$5.00. This fee must be paid at the time of screening and re-screening.

#### **Re-Screening Process**

Volunteer screening is repeated every five years based on geographic location regardless of when the original screening was completed. When it is time for re-screening, volunteers will be prompted with instructions for completing the online re-screening process. See <u>Volunteer Screening</u> <u>Schedule</u>.

# **YOUTH** THE QUALITY CARE

Nebraska 4-H **requires** all youth enrolled in livestock projects to complete annual quality assurance certification through <u>Youth for</u> the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA). YQCA is a national multi-species quality assurance program focused on three core pillars: food safety, animal well-being, and character development. Requirements

YQCA certification is required for all 4-H members enrolled in any of the following projects:

- Beef (bucket calf, feeder calf, breeding beef, market beef)
- · Dairy Cattle
- Goat (breeding meat goat, dairy goat, meat goat)
- · Poultry
- · Rabbit
- · Sheep (breeding sheep, market sheep)
- · Swine (breeding swine, market swine
- YQCA is **required** annually.

**Face-to Face Training** In-person YQCA training courses cost **\$3 per individual** regardless of age. Dates to be determined. Be watching your 4-H Newsletter!

**Web-based Training** at <u>https://yqca.learngrow.io/Account/Login</u>. The online YQCA course costs **\$12 per individual** regardless of age.

**Test-out options** are only available to youth in the first year of Intermediate (age 12) and Senior (age 15) age levels. There is no test-out option for Juniors. Participants will have <u>only one chance</u> to take the test-out option. If youth fail, they will not be provided another opportunity to test out of that age level.

Test-out costs are:

Intermediate: \$36 (\$12 x 3 years of certification) Senior: \$48 (\$12 x 4 years of certification).

### **State Fair Livestock Exhibitors**

- New in 2024 Changes to State Fair Age Eligibility! All 4-H members who were at least 8 years of age on December 31 of previous year will be eligible to show livestock at the Nebraska State Fair. Learn more about State Fair: <u>4h.unl.edu/state-fair</u>.
- Online Livestock Nominations Any animals that you are considering and would like to be eligible to show at State Fair, will need to be nominated and paid online (\$7 per animal), by YOU (4-H families) at <u>showstockmgr.com</u>. The deadline for all animals is June 14. \*The official State Fair nomination deadline is June 15; however, that is a Saturday. Our office WILL NOT be open or be able to answer questions on the 15th; therefore, we STRONGLY SUGGEST that you complete your nominations by June 14.
- DNA Samples will need pulled for ALL animals that are nominated market, breeding & feeder calves (this applies to Beef, Swine, Sheep & Goats). Please pick up DNA envelopes at the Extension Office for any animals that you plan to nominate & return completed envelopes with samples by June 14 (see \* above). \*\*Multiple exhibitors in the same immediate family may be listed on each DNA envelope, but <u>ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SIGN THEIR SIGNATURES ON EACH ENVELOPE</u>. (This is NEW for 2024.)

#### **4-H Cat Rules**

Cats and Ferrets are required to have completed vaccination forms filed with the Extension Office by July 10. This form must be signed by a vet. All cats, owned by 4-H age youth and Clover Kid age youth are included in this requirement. Minimum age for a cat to be shown is four months. The cat should be brought to the fair in a durable carrier. Cats are required to be on a leash at any time they are removed from the carrier.

### **Dog Vaccination and Owner Forms**

All dogs are **required** to have completed vaccination records on file in the Extension Office by July 10. This includes 4-H age showman and Clover Kid age showman. This form **must be signed** by your vet.

Phelps County also requires an ownership form completed by July 10. All forms are available in the Extension Office. The office can email you the needed forms.



#### **Dog Achievement Program**

The Nebraska 4-H Dog Achievement Program encourages youth to engage in a variety of companion animal opportunities, events, and contests. The program is designed to equip youth with a variety of skills and abilities and prepare them for success in the future. The Dog Achievement Program is open to enrolled 4-H members ages 8-18.

### **Dog Achievement Program**

The program consists of 4 levels that require youth to plan and report a broad range of ageappropriate accomplishments. For each level, the Dog Achievement program provides a list of recommended accomplishments from which 4-H youth choose their goals. At each level, youth must choose a specific number of recommended accomplishments they plan to achieve. Each level also has a certain number of required accomplishments that youth must complete in order to pass the level. The accomplishments increase in quantity and difficulty for each level. At the beginning of the level, participants plan what to accomplish and at the end, they report on their completed accomplishments. Successful completion of a level's Plan & Report form results in a 4-H youth earning that level of the Dog Achievement program.
