Projects for Clover Kid members, ages 5 to 7, current year, in the Phelps or Gosper County 4-H program. Phelps and Gosper Clover Kids will receive a **\$3 premium per livestock Exhibit**. Phelps County and Gosper County Clover Kids will receive a **\$1 premium per each Static Exhibit**.

Animal Caretaker Exhibits

Each Clover Kid may bring **one** entry per species in the classes listed below if they are enrolled in a Clover Kid Animal Project. (Example: Clover Kid Animal Caretaker, Exploring Animals, Clover Kid Bottle Fed Lamb, Clover Kid Chickens, Clover Kid Rabbit, or others)

Clover Kids may share an animal owned and properly identified by an older sibling in Phelps and Gosper Counties. All animals must meet health requirements.

Dogs and Cats must be properly vaccinated and the 4-H vaccination sheet must be completed.

• <u>PHELPS Co. Clover Kid Bucket Calf</u> must complete the Clover Kid Bucket Calf affidavit (I908001). All Clover Kids will receive a 4-H Rainbow Ribbon. No record book required for Phelps County.

• <u>GOSPER Co. Clover Kid Bucket Calf</u> must complete the Clover Kid Bucket Calf affidavit. Complete the CK Bucket Calf Record Book and turn it into the Ag Barn Office on Wednesday during the Livestock Entry period. There will be no individual questioning by a judge or teens. All Clover Kids will receive a 4-H Rainbow Ribbon.

●4-H CLOVER KIDS IN GOSPER AND PHELPS COUNTY

Clover Kids is a special 4-H program for youth ages 5-7. Youth who have enrolled in a designated Clover Kids project anytime during the project year may bring an exhibit to the County Fair for display. Exhibits will be displayed during the fair. Exhibits will not be judged. Exhibits can be anything made by the Clover Kids member in support of the project taken.

Clover Kids may exhibit up to three (3) entries in each 4-H project in which they have enrolled, with the exception of animal entries. Clover Kids may exhibit one animal per entry (species) under Exploring Animals (Letter I).

Clover Kids may "share" an animal for display at the county fair with a sibling that has properly identified their animal exhibit. Clover Kids are asked to identify their animals by the appropriate deadline but it is not required. Clover Kid animal entries must meet health and vaccination requirements as listed under the appropriate specie in the fair book.

Pre-entry is necessary for Clover Kids exhibits. Exploring Animals exhibits in Clover Kids are presented during the corresponding 4-H show. For example, Clover Kid Bucket Calves will be presented during the regular 4-H Bucket Calf show. Non animal Clover Kid exhibits are entered on Entry Day with the 4-H Static Exhibits.
