Class G040909: The 4-H Dairy Show is open to grade and registered dairy animals. Grade & registered dairy animals will be shown together. Animals without registration information or with incomplete identification will be shown as grade animals. Dairy animals must be identified in accordance with 4-H rules prior to June 15 of current calendar year.

A 4-H member is limited to three dairy animals. If the three qualify as a Junior herd, they may be shown in a Herd Class. As numbers warrant, animals will be shown by age class and breed.

DAIRY HERD.....Class G44915

Exhibitors in the Dairy Herd class will enter three females. At least one of the three must be a cow that has freshened and has been fresh long enough to have a projected 305 day M.E. At least one animal must qualify as bred by exhibitor, and all three must be of the same breed. They must pre-enter to qualify.
