

GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

Purple 4.00 Blue 3.75 Red 3.00 White 2.25

Class G10901- Sr Showmanship, age 14 & up

Class G10902 Inter Showmanship, age 11-13

Class G10903-Jr Showmanship, age 8-10 year

Goat showmanship will include Meat Goat, Breeding Meat Goat, and Dairy Goat exhibitors. Phelps County will allow Novelty Goat.

Dairy Goats cannot be shown in Meat Goat classes and Meat Goats cannot be shown in Dairy Goat classes.

MEAT GOAT

County ID Required: County Livestock Affidavit with a Scrapie Tag identifying animals

LIMIT: 3 Market Goats, 1 Lottery Goat, 2 Breeding Goats, 3 Dairy Goats. Phelps has addition of Novelty Goat.

ID Deadline: June 15th

Meat Goats to be shown at State Fair MUST have hair sample for DNA on file. Deadline for DNA and online nomination is June 15th.

The meat goat project is designed for animals showing meat qualities such as the goats with the Boer influence; no hair, dairy or miniature goats will be included in the project.

Goat ID: All does (market & breeding) must have USDA Scrapie tag in place as identification and part of scrapie eradication program. All market goats must be listed on Market goat affidavit and Breeding goats on separate Breeding goat affidavit.

Goats should be a minimum of 45 lbs and a maximum of 125 lbs. After weighing, goats will be divided into weight classes depending on the number of entries and at the superintendent's discretion. Exhibitors may enter a maximum of three goats. All goats must be carrying all milk teeth at the time of weigh-in. All goats are recommended to have horns blunted. Only wether and female kids may be shown - no billies.

Milk teeth may be randomly checked at weigh-in.

BREEDING MEAT GOAT

County ID Required: County Livestock Affidavit with a Scrapie Tag identifying animals

LIMIT: 2 Breeding Goats per exhibitor

ID Deadline: June 15th

Purple 4.00, Blue 3.75, Red 3.00, White, 2.25.

Class G59010 Yearling Does (Does born 9/1/2022 to 8/31/2023) Does born prior to 9/1/2022 are ineligible to show.

Class G59020 Doe Kids (Does born 9/1/2023 to 4/1/2024)

A. All breeding does may be mouthed for age. All doe kids must have all lamb or temporary teeth present; yearling does can have yearling teeth, but cannot have two-year old teeth up. Does exhibiting two-year old teeth will be allowed to show, but will not be eligible to compete for championship.

B. Breeding Does must be ear tagged or tattooed. Registered does must be registered with the breed association by entry date and have the flock tag, or tattoo and registration tag (if required by breed association). Full scrapie tag number must be on the registration paper. Registration must be completed by fair date and a copy of the registration papers must accompany State Fair entry. Both commercial and registered does must have an official USDA (scrapie) identification tag on the ID affidavit (4-HF-105) and be in the animal's ear at check-in. Both commercial does and registered does will show together.

NOVELTY GOAT (Phelps Co. Only)

County ID Required: County Livestock Affidavit with farm ear tags identifying animals

LIMIT: 3 Novelty Goats per exhibitor

ID Deadline: June 15th

Class G959950

Novelty Goats will be shown by breed and age where necessary. Species should not be considered meat/market animals. Novelty breed animals will not be eligible to be sold in the Auction. Breeds may include, but are not limited to: Pygmy, Fainting, etc.

DAIRY GOAT

County ID Required: County Livestock ID with **farm ear tag numbers** identifying animals <u>LIMIT:</u> 3 Dairy Goats per exhibitor <u>ID Deadline</u>: June 15th *Purple 4.00, Blue 3.75, Red 3.00, White, 2.25.* Dairy Goats will be shown by breed and age where necessary.
