June 15th Checklist Have you... 1. Enrolled in 4-H? Go to https://v2.4honline.com - youth must be enrolled on 4-H Online to be eligible to exhibit at the Pierce County and State Fair. 2. Turned in your ID Forms? All County Fair ID Forms (Affidavits) for Breeding and Market Beef, Bucket Calf, Feeder Calf, Cow/Calf Pairs, Dairy Cattle; Breeding, Market, and Dairy Goats, Horse, Breeding and Market Sheep, Rabbits, and Swine are due. It is your responsibility to make sure these forms are accurate. All necessary data must be present and correct. Can email or bring to the office. All ID papers are available for download at https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/pierce/4-h-animal-information-0/. 3. Completed Online Nominations for State Fair? Instructions for nominating State Fair Livestock are available at https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/pierce/4-h-animal-information-0/. Made nominations at: https://showstockmgr.com and brought your DNA envelopes for State Fair for all Market and Breeding Livestock and Feeder Calves to the Extension Office? A new document has been created for families wanting to exhibit animals at the State Fair. 4. Obtained premise ID number if animals have an EID tag? July Deadlines

The following are due to the Extension Office. You may bring them to the office or email to pierce-county@unl.edu:

• July 1st - Aksarben Stock Show nominate online by 5 p.m. You can find specific instructions for dual nominations and the link to do so by visiting aksarbenstockshow.com.

- July 1st YQCA Certificates are DUE to the Pierce County Extension Office. All 4-Hers enrolled in the breeding and market beef; bucket calf; feeder calf; cow/calf; dairy cattle; breeding meat, market, dairy, and pygmy goats; breeding and market sheep, swine, rabbit, and poultry projects are required to complete the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) course. The online course can be found at https://yqcaprogram.org/. Instructions are available on the website under Youth and Parents | Web-based Training Help Document. All individuals that complete the web-based option, test-out option, or attend a Face-to-Face training other than those held in Wayne or Pierce will need to go back into their https://yqcaprogram.org account to download their certificate. Either email or print it off and bring it to the Extension Office. 4-HOnline and the YQCA site do not communicate.
- July 3rd Entry information for Static Entries, Clothing Entry and Time Sheet, Small Animal Entry Form, and Livestock Entry Form are Due at the Pierce County Extension Office. You would have received these form with your Premium Book. You can find Entry Forms on our website at https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/pierce/pierce-county-fair-information/. You can drop them off at the Extension Office or email them.
- July 3rd Food Revue Menu are due to the Pierce County Extension Office.
- July 5th Small Animal Current Vaccinations Records due at Pierce County Extension Office
- July 12th Best Buy for Your Buck Notebooks for Shopping in Style are due at the Pierce County Extension Office.
- July 15th Horse Advancement level testing LAST DAY to take Horse level tests at the Pierce County Extension Office.
- July 24th Vegetable, Floral, and Swine Entry Forms DUE when you come to the Fair.

4-H Livestock News

Livestock Quality Assurance 2024



There's much more to 4-H livestock projects than simply showing animals at the fair. That's why all Nebraska 4-H members enrolled in livestock projects must complete annual quality assurance training. Through the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals program, members learn about food safety and animal well-being. Youth enrolled in beef, dairy cattle, goat, poultry, rabbit, sheep, and swine projects may complete online training courses or attend in-person training workshops held by their county Extension office. Face-to-Face Training

Face-to-Face trainings are scheduled for June 11th (1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.) at the Pierce County Fairgrounds. To register for this Face to Face training you will need go to the YQCA website is yqcaprogram.org. Log on and select "Pierce County YQCA" and the time that you want (either 1 pm or 6 pm). After you have selected your time will have to pay a \$3 fee per youth. This fee has to be paid online and not in the office. Pierce County 4-Hers - if you attend the in person training at the Pierce County YQCA, we will be reimbursing you the \$3 at the event for coming to the in person training.


Aksarbren Stock Show

This year Aksarben Stock Show will still be accepting dual nominations of livestock between the Nebraska State Fair and Aksarben Stock Show. You do NOT need to purchase additional DNA envelopes for animals you're nominating for State Fair.

NEW for 2024, an additional step is <u>REQUIRED</u>, you will need to online nominate your animal through the Aksarben Stock Show by <u>5 P.M. on July 1st</u> to be able to show at the Aksarben Stock Show.


