All workshops are filled on a first-come-first-serve basis. So call or register early to get your spot this summer. 4-H membership is not required.

May 29th: Wayne YQCA Face to Face (Quality Assurance): 1-2 PM OR 6-7 PM, Wayne County Fairgrounds

Are you planning on showing Beef, Dairy Cattle, Goat, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep, or swine at County Fair, State Fair, or Aksarben? If so, you must complete Quality Assurance. This can be completed online or at a face to face training. For both the face to face training and completing it online you must register online at https://yqcaprogram.org. To register for this Face to Face training you will need to log on and select "Wayne County YQCA" and the time that you want (either 1 pm or 6 pm). After you have selected your time will have to pay a \$3 fee per youth. This fee has to be paid online and not in the office. If you attend the in person training Pierce County 4-Hers will be reimbursed at a later date.

Join us as we explore the world of upcycling as we repurpose old picture frames. Participants will also discover the science behind glass etching on glass landscaping blocks.

June 6th: Insect Collection Workshop: 9 – 4 PM, Pierce County Extension Office in the Meeting Room

Cost: \$40, Age: 8+, Must have five 4-Hers registered to be held and limit of ten 4-Hers.

Start your entomology collection or just learn about these tiny creatures that are all around us! Identify, collect, and preserve the basic kinds of insects, as well as learn about insect lifecycles. As part of the workshop, participants will receive insect pins, a display box, labeling materials, and a basic identification guide.

- * Bring a sack lunch and dress appropriately for spending the day outside in the sun.
- * Each participant will need to bring their own straight-sided jar. Pickle jars work well. No canning jars.

June 7th: Summer Building Better Babysitter: 10-3:30 PM, Wayne County Fairgrounds

Cost: \$20, Age: 8+, Registration Due June 3rd

During this workshop you will complete a class that teaches you about the business of babysitting, child development, basic first aid & safety, food & nutrition, entertainment, and much more! Youth ages 10 and above are encouraged to attend!

Explore the wonderful art of creating a double crust fruit pie! We will discover the different of using butter, lard, and shortening crusts to make the perfect flaky crust! Each participant will get to make their own 4 inch fruit

Unleash your creativity and learn the art of arranging flowers. This workshop offers hands-on guidance to help you master various techniques and create a fair worthy floral design. Youth will explore principles and elements using silk flowers while arranging in adorable baskets.

June 26th: Build a lamp: 9-11 AM, Pavilion at Pierce County Fairgrounds

Learn about sirens, how to prepare for a emergency by building a disaster/emergency kit (1 per family), and have a fire escape plan made for your home. You will need to bring a set of clothes and socks to pack into the kit. There will be more things required to add at home to complete the requirements. A list will be provided.

June 28th: Critter Korner - Learn about Nebraska's wildlife: 10:30 AM - 12 PM, Pavilion at Pierce County Fairgrounds Cost: \$5, Ages: 8+, Registration Due: June 12th

You will get a chance to see furs, skulls, artifacts and learn about how animals survive in the winter. Search for tracks and even make tracks to take home.
