They are \$5 for regular members and \$2 for Clover Buds. Dues must be paid before County Fair premiums can be issued.

#### **Selected for State Fair**

If your static (non-livestock) exhibit at the Pierce County Fair is selected for State Fair, please plan on bringing your exhibit to the Extension Office on Tuesday, August 20th. The office will remain open until 7:00 pm on that date to receive entries. If you are planning on taking Horticulture or Floriculture exhibits to the state fair, you will need to call the Extension Office before 12 on Monday, August 19 with your information so tags can be printed for the exhibit. State Fair Exhibits will be ready for pick up from the Extension Office on Wed, Sept. 4th.

- STATE FAIR INFORMATION—The State Fair is scheduled for Aug. 23 Sep. 2.
- Information about the Nebraska State Fair, including photos and results, can be found at http://4h.unl.edu/ nebraskastatefair. This is a great way to track the progress of local 4-H members and their exhibits.
- State Fair premium books are available at http://4h.unl.edu or at the Extension Office.
- State Fair ticket information: New in 2019 4-H youth exhibiting static exhibits at the Nebraska State Fair will order advance discount tickets directly from the Nebraska State Fair. Discount tickets will no longer be available through the county offices.
  - Non-exhibitor ticket prices and discount ticket pass information can be found at: https://www.statefair.org/ plan-your-visit/pricing.
  - Daily gate admission for ages 13-59 will be \$12.00, with \$6.00 days on Monday through Thursday.
  - Tickets for seniors (ages 60 and older) is \$5.00, youth 6-12 years of age are \$3.00, and children 5 years of age and younger will be free each day.


