Pierce County Speech Contest

The Public Speaking Contest will be held at 7 p.m. on March 21, 2023 at the Pierce County Extension Meeting Room. Registration for the event is due on March 17, 2023 by calling (402) 329-4821 or emailing Pierce-County@unl.edu with your name, whether doing a speech or Illustrated Presentation or PSA or both, the title of the speech and age division. The top five contestants in each of the intermediate and senior divisions of each category (Speech & PSA & Illustrated Presentation) are eligible to represent Pierce County at the state-level communication contests on June 23, 2023 in Lincoln.

Speech Category Guidelines:

- Length :
 - Junior Division (age 8-9): 1-3 minutes
 - Intermediate Division (ages 10-13): 3-5 minutes
 - Senior Division (age 14-18): 5-8 minutes
 - For Senior Division only, judges will deduct three points from the score for every 30 seconds under or over the time limit.
- Only individuals may compete in this class; no team entries are allowed
- All speeches may not be original and include 4-H as the major component of the speech.
- Clover Buds 4-Hers 5-7 years. May read a poem or story, or talk to the audience about any topic they choose. May be written by 4-Her or someone else. Suggested length: under 2 minutes.

Illustrated Presentation Category Guidelines:

- Length
 - Individual (all age divisions): 6-8 minutes
 - Team (all age divisions): 8-10 minutes
 - Participants will be penalized if their presentation exceeds the time limit
- An Illustrated Presentation may be given by one (1) individual or a team of two (2) individuals. If team members are not in the same age division, they must complete in the age division of the oldest team member.
- All presentation topics should be related to what the 4-H youth is learning through 4-H educational experiences.

Livestock Premises ID

All 4-H and FFA market animals with an EID tag are required to have a Premises ID. A Premises ID can be obtained through the Nebraska Department of Agriculture and should correlate to the location in which livestock are kept/housed permanently.

- Only one Premises ID is necessary for a family with multiple exhibitors (provided livestock are housed at the same location).
- Only one Premises ID is necessary for an exhibitor that shows multiple species (provided livestock is housed at the same location).
- Any exhibitor that has completed Quality Assurance or YQCA and exhibited an animal with an EID tag at the Pierce County Fair will have a Premises ID.

State Fair Age Change

With each new State Fair season, brings new possibilities and opportunities for 4-H families in Nebraska. The opportunity for 4-H to continue having its own weekend allows more flexibility for new events, entry limits, schedules, and space. We want to continue to take advantage of that!

As part of that process, we continue to explore age eligibility requirements for State Fair participation. After garnering user input, researching data from other events/shows/states, and looking that overall impact on youth development, the decision has been made to change the **age of eligibility in 2023 to be 9 years of age before January 1 (of the current year) for all in-person events (livestock, contests, fashion shows)**.

Livestock Quality Assurance 2023 Tor YUCA

All youth planning to show beef, bucket calf, dairy, goats, poultry, rabbit, sheep, and swine at the Pierce County Fair, Nebraska State Fair, or Ak-Sar-Ben must complete YQCA training. This can be completed at a Face-to-Face training or online. Face-to-Face trainings are scheduled for May 31 (1 p.m. and 6 p.m.) at the Wayne County Fairgrounds and June 6 (1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.) at the Pierce County Fairgrounds.
