INDIVIDUALS MAY ONLY PERFORM IN TWO PERFORMANCES DURING THE SHOW. COUNTY FAIR ONLY

RULES: A) Each group must have three or more participants, all must be 4-H members. B) Dress - Each participant will wear a 4-H Chevron or other prominent 4-H identification. Chevrons may be obtained from the Extension Office. The performing group may not use identification of a specific club, county or organization other than 4-H. C) Time - Each group/performer is allowed two minutes after the cue from the contest chair to arrange themselves on stage and begin performing. Props, if used, must be in place within the time limit. The performance of each person/group is limited to not more than six minutes. D) Selection - Any number of selections may be performed within the six minute time limit. E) Accompaniment - Recorded background music may be used, except for musical instrument performance. Participants must bring their own tape or record player if recorded accompaniment is used. Piano, guitar or other instruments may accompany other performers. Live accompaniment, if used, may be by a 4-H member, parent or leader. Not more than one adult may accompany the group. F) Song groups, combos, and bands may appear with or without a director. The director of a group must be a 4-H member.
