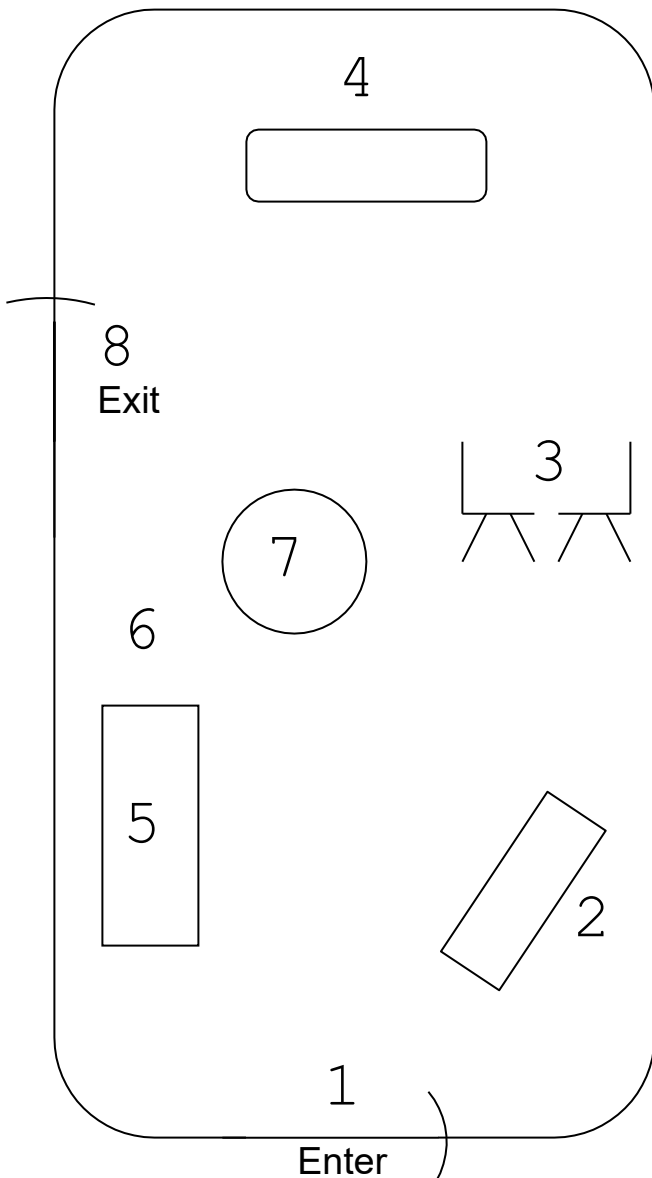


Bucket Calf Obstacle Course

Exhibitors are to do each obstacle by themselves with no help. Exhibitor is given about 2 minutes to complete each obstacle. There should be a distance of 12 inches of lead rope between exhibitor's hand and chin of goat or calf. Goat or Calf's head should be held high.



Calf lead by halter.

1. Unchain arena gate, enter and re-chain gate.
2. Lead calf over the bridge, keeping all four legs on the bridge. (Bridge is a sheet of plywood on 4x4's without sides.)
3. Lead calf between chairs/show boxes, which are two feet apart. Superintendents sitting on chairs. (Loud radio is optional.)
4. Lead calf over sheet of blue plastic tarp. (Tarp will be folded several times to make it a little fluffy and only 4x6' in size.)
5. Lead calf into stock trailer, turn it around and lead it back out.
6. Tie calf to outside of stock trailer using a slip knot. Judge will inspect/untie knot.
7. Take end of halter rope and walk around the animal.
8. Unchain arena exit gate, lead calf out, then close and re-chain gate.

In the future, it is possible to:

1. Use small gate in trailer.
2. Put loud music in trailer.
3. Lead over (3) 8" logs.
