-All Horse level changes need to be completed and turned into the office by **May 6th**. This includes all the written paperwork along with the riding test. If you do not remember what level you have completed, please feel free to contact our office and myself and we can let you know we will share it with you.

If you need to purchase an official 4-H Arm Band, they are available in our office for a small cost.
