Dear 4-H Families,

The Polk County Fair will be here before we know it! We are again going with the pre-entry procedure for fair. This means that it is time to start thinking about the exhibits that you are going to enter at fair. You will find all the forms and information using this link: <https://go.unl.edu/2022polkcofair>. Each 4-Her MUST have their own sheet. This needs to be return to the Extension office by **Wednesday, June 29th. The Static (Items brought to the fair exhibit building on entry day) pre-entry forms must be completed and returned. You will ONLY be able to enter up to FIVE Exhibits NOT listed on the Pre-Fair Entry form the morning of check-in.** Therefore, write down everything that you think you might bring in 4-H on the pre-entry forms. There is no penalty for not bringing items that you wrote down.

If you are showing Horticulture/Floriculture fresh vegetables and/or flowers. **There is an additional Horticulture Entry form that you will need to fill out, follow directions for labeling your exhibits, and bring both the form and labeled exhibits the morning of check-in.**

If you are showing Animals, please watch your email for more information coming soon!

Please be sure to check the fair schedule found on our web page for additional information, including dates and times.
