According to the Polk County 4-H Program records, one or more members of your family were enrolled in the 4-H beef project and/or have identified at least one 4-H/FFA project beef animal (market, breeding, feeder calf and/or bucket calf) in 2023 and/or 2024. Because of your past involvement, we are notifying you of important market beef identification updates for 2024. There are always a few changes made each year, therefore, <u>please closely review the enclosed information</u>.

Important STATE FAIR Highlights for 2024 - Reminders

- DNA for All Nominations
 - All 4-H/FFA BREEDING livestock, market livestock and FEEDER CALVES will again be required to submit a DNA sample/envelope to be eligible to exhibit at the Nebraska State Fair.
- Age of Eligibility
 - The age of eligibility in 2024 is now 8 years of age before January 1 (of the current year) for all in-person events (livestock, contests, fashion shows)

BEEF - MARKET BEEF

- ALL 4-H/FFA market beef are required to be identified with:
 - State Fair/AKSARBEN with a 4-H/FFA EID tag (\$3.00 EID Tag Fee). (NOTE: Animals may use existing official EID "840" tags that are currently in the animal's ear)
 - OR County Fair only 4-H/FFA Market Beef with a county only tag (\$1.00 County Tag Fee)
- Market Beef identification limit is 10 animals per exhibitor (regardless of 4-H or FFA).
- 4-H/FFA animals to be eligible for Nebraska State Fair/AKSARBEN:
 - o Required to be identified with an official 4-H/FFA EID tag (\$3.00 EID Tag Fee.).
 - Required to complete and submit a <u>DNA sample envelope by JUNE 15th.</u>
 - \$7.00/envelope Fee will be collected online when 4-H member/FFA student enters information into ASKSARBEN DATABASE just like last year. The database information and link is included on a separate page.
 - 4-H members/FFA students using an EID tag will NOT be required to complete an additional county identification form as long as they have completed the information on the DNA envelope.
 - As exhibitors enter their 4-H/FFA animals for the Nebraska State Fair (online system by August 10), they will be required to designate 4-H OR FFA entry.
- The State Fair EID tag is considered as both 4-H and FFA. Therefore.
 - o if the owner is a 4-H member, the animal is considered 4-H,
 - o if the owner is a FFA student, the animal is considered FFA, and
 - o if the owner is both a 4-H member and a FFA student, the animal is considered both 4-H and FFA.
 - HOWEVER, an animal may only be exhibited at ONE county fair. Once the animal exhibits at a county fair it will NOT be eligible to exhibit at another county fair.



- 4-H/FFA animals that are exhibiting <u>COUNTY ONLY:</u>
 - o Required to be identified with an official Polk County 4-H/FFA ID tag (\$1 Animal Tag Fee).
 - Required to complete and submit a county identification form.
- ALL MARKET BEEF PAPERWORK DNA envelopes and county identification forms are due by the <u>JUNE 15th</u>
 <u>DEADLINE</u> to the Extension Office in Polk County. DNA Nomination information MUST be entered in the
 ASKSARBEN ONLINE DATA BASE AND FEE PAID by <u>JUNE 15th</u>.
- 4-H/FFA LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION DEADLINE: All tagging, tattooing, ear notching and DNA sampling
 MUST be completed by the DEADLINE DATE (Market Beef JUNE 15 for both State and County). In other
 words, 4-H/ FFA livestock projects are NOT to be tagged, tattooed, ear notched and/or DNA sampled <u>AFTER</u>
 the deadline date. All identification procedures are to be completed by the set deadline. Any 4-H livestock
 identified AFTER the DEADLINE DATE will NOT be ELIGIBLE to exhibit in the 2024 livestock shows (Polk
 County Fair, Nebraska State Fair 4-H Shows, and AKSARBEN 4-H Stock Show).
- A heifer that is identified as a market heifer by JUNE 15 can be also be identified as breeding by the June 15 deadline.
 - ✓ To be eligible for state fair and/or AKSARBEN, the heifer must be nominated on the AKSARBEN ONLINE DATA BASE with a DNA Sample and Tattoo and submitted by June 15.
 - ✓ To be eligible for the county fair, the heifer must have a Nebraska 4-H and FFA Breeding Beef Ownership Affidavits completed and submitted to our office by June 15.
 - ✓ All breeding heifers must have a tattoo for State Shows but may have a Polk County Tag for County Show only.

RATE OF GAIN/MARKET BEEF WEIGH DAY:

- ✓ Since State Fair and AKSARBEN have eliminated their rate of gain contests, it is no longer required for counties to hold weigh days. Therefore 4-H/FFA families may tag, identify and/or DNA sample on their own if they choose.
- ✓ If 4-H/FFA families are unable to attend the 4-H/FFA Market Beef Weigh Day (Saturday, February 3rd/ Osceola Veterinarian Hospital) OR plan to identify on their own, they will be responsible for obtaining the official 4-H/FFA EID or Polk County 4-H tags and paperwork (DNA envelopes and/or county identification forms) from our office. ALL PAPERWORK AND PAYMENTS must be completed and submitted by JUNE 15 DEADLINE to the AKSARBEN ONLINE DATA BASE for EID or for County to the Polk County Extension Office by closing at 4:30 p.m. (June 15th is a Saturday, so all information can be placed in Courthouse Drop Box by 8:00 a.m. on Monday, June 17th and still be eligible)
- ✓ To be eligible for Rate of Gain at County fair animals must be weighed in within 7 days prior to or after the February 3rd event. Contact Colleen for more information.

2024 POLK COUNTY LIVESTOCK PROJECT MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

ONLINE 4-H ENROLLMENT

Polk County 4-H online enrollment completed by MANDATORY RE-ENROLLMENT DEADLINE: JUNE 15, 2024

4-H livestock (except horse – June 1 (State)/June 15 (County) and all other project member enrollments are required by JUNE 15, 2024. 4-H members enrolling AFTER the June 15 deadline will NOT be ELIGIBLE to exhibit in the 2024 fairs/shows.

2024: An annual \$5 enrollment fee per 4-H member (5-18 years old BEFORE January 1, 2024) will be implemented if reenrolled by JUNE 15, 2024. 4-H organizational and project leaders will continue to have no enrollment fee.

MARKET BEEF IDENTIFICATION

4-H/FFA Market Beef to be eligible for Nebraska State Fair/AKSARBEN:

- Required to be identified with an official 4-H/FFA EID tag (\$3.00 each).
- ✓ Required to complete and submit a DNA sample envelope (\$7 each paid when information is entered online).

4-H/FFA Market Beef that are COUNTY ONLY:

- Required to be identified with an official Polk County 4-H tag (\$1 each).
- Required to complete and submit a county identification form.

ALL MARKET BEEF PAPERWORK – DNA envelopes and county identification forms are due by the JUNE 15 DEADLINE to the Nebraska Extension Office in Polk County. And all DNA & EID tags must be entered in the AKSARBEN database online.

4-H/FFA LIVESTOCK IDENTIFICATION

For all other 4-H/FFA livestock (except horses) - DNA envelopes, Breeding Nomination Forms, county identification forms, and copies of registration sheets are due by the JUNE 15 DEADLINE to the Polk County Extension Office. And all DNA & EID/TATOO information must be entered in the ASKSARBEN database online.

LIVESTOCK QUALITY ASSURANCE (QA) CERTIFICATION

The Nebraska 4-H Program is REQUIRING 4-H and FFA members (8-18 years old) exhibiting beef, sheep, swine, dairy cattle, goats, poultry and rabbits to be certified in Quality Assurance. This program is mandated by the Nebraska 4-H program and is implemented into the Polk County 4-H Program. Therefore, youth exhibiting BEEF, SHEEP, SWINE, DAIRY CATTLE, GOATS, POULTRY and/or RABBITS at the Polk County Fair, Nebraska State Fair and AKSARBEN 4-H Stock Show are required to be QA certified by June 15 OF THE CURRENT YEAR to be eligible to exhibit.

Youth Quality Care of Animals (QA) in 2024

The Nebraska 4-H Program will be using the YQCA Certification to a national based online program that was introduced last year.
