# YOUTH QUALITY CARE ANIMALS



#### WHO IS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE YOCA TRAINING?

4-H (ages 8-18) and FFA (under age 19) exhibitors as of Jan. 1st of the current year who exhibit beef, goats, sheep, swine, rabbit, and poultry MUST complete quality assurance training through YQCA (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) by <u>June 1, 2023</u> to be eligible to exhibit at the County Fair and State Fair.

Clover Kids ages 5-7 (as of Jan. 1, 2023) <u>DO NOT</u> need to complete quality assurance training.

Youth ages 8-18 (as of Jan. 1, 2023) have two options for completing their YQCA training.

Instructor Led Trainings - Dec. 29 at 10:30 am or 1 pm at the Extension Office in Wilber Register online by NOON on Dec. 28th.

#### **OPTION 1**

INSTUCTOR LED TRAINING FOR 4-H & FFA
YOUTH AGES 8-18 (JAN. 1) ONLY

THIS IS A NEW WEBSITE WITH NEW INSTRUCTIONS.

Everyone is required to set up a account and add your youth into this account if you completed your training before before March 15 of 2022. DO NO CREATE DUPLICATE ACCOUNST AND DO NOT USE THE OLD YOCA WEBSITE.

Steps to complete your pre-registration:

- 1. 4-H members need to be enrolled in 4HOnline for 2023 before you can register for YQCA: https://v2.4honline.com/ (type link into your web browser)
- 2. Must call 402-821-2151 or email becky.vales@unl.edu to let us know you are planning to attend.
- 3. Register AND pay online at: https://yqcaprogram.org Cost is \$3 paid online.

# **CHANGES FOR 2023**

# ALL 4-H/FFA BREEDING LIVESTOCK (BEEF, GOATS, SHEEP, AND SWINE) AND FEEDER CALVES WILL NOW BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT DNA/ ENVELOPE TO BE ELIGIBLE TO EXHIBIT AT THE NEBRASKA STATE FAIR.

The cost of each DNA/envelope is \$7.00 which is paid online at the time of making your livestock nominations in Show Stock Manager by the June 15, 2023 deadline.

Families will need to get the DNA envelopes from the Extension Office for <u>ALL BREEDING ANIMALS</u>, <u>MARKET ANIMALS</u> & <u>FEEDER CALVES which you want to nominate for State Fair</u> to collect the DNA samples. DNA envelopes must be returned to the Extension office by June 15. Late envelopes WILL NOT be accepted.

Any DNA nomination submitted through Show Stock Manager will also be eligible for entry at the Ak-Sar-Ben Stock Show. Submitting a DNA envelope DOES NOT serve as an entry for any show.

## 2023 Special Garden Project Mrs. Burns' Lemon Basil



This project is open to all youth of 4-H age and it will give them the opportunity to learn about growing, harvesting, and exhibiting this unique herb.

The Special Gardening Project lets 4-H members try their hand at growing unusual vegetables, flowers, and herbs. The project allows experienced 4-H gardeners to grow something fun, new, and different while letting those new to gardening get their feet wet in this project area.

The focus of the 2023 project is Mrs. Burns' Lemon Basil. This herb can be used multiple ways. Lemon basil has a unique lemon flavor can be added to any recipe or to cut flower arrangements to add scent and interest.

#### 4-H members enrolled in the Special Garden Project will:

- Receive a 'packet' of Mrs. Burns' Lemon Basil (one packet per youth) in March/April
- Receive a newsletter about:
  - o Planting & growing basil
  - o Basil problems & insects
  - Harvesting & using basil
- Be able to exhibit this unique herb at County and State Fair
  - o State Fair Special Garden Project Educational Exhibit Class G-775-001
  - o State Fair Special Garden Project Fresh Cut Flowers or Harvested Vegetables & HerbsG-775-002
  - o Other fun county only ways to exhibit this unique herb like a story, poem, or poster. Each county is different so be sure to check with your local Extension Office.
