Requirements and Guidelines:

- Saline County 4-H Members ages 8-10 are eligible to apply for this award.
- If applying for Rookie Member – **DO NOT APPLY FOR THIS AWARD IF YOU ARE IN THIS AGE RANGE.**
- A member's age does not affect their eligibility to apply for this award. Age does however have to be 4-H age (ages 8-18 as of Jan. 1 of the current year). Some contests are age restricted.
- 4-H members who do not submit this application will not be considered for this award.
- The application consists of a point-based checklist. The member with the highest points total will earn the award. **ONE** award given per year.
- Tie Breaker will be based on the submissions and completeness of your Saline County 4-H Achievement & Activity Record. While the 4-H Achievement & Activity Record is not required to receive your fair premium money, **IT IS** required to be submitted with this application.
- This application should have dates and details of activities, involvement, and projects from the **CURRENT 4-H Year ONLY**. Activities, involvement, and projects from prior years will not be accepted.
- Attached documentation/confirmation of registration/copy of receipt for any Nebraska 4-H sponsored event you attend such a Nebraska 4-H Camp, PASE, Winners Unlimited Livestock Judging Camp, State Horse Show, etc.
- **ALL ENTERED INFORMATION IN THIS APPLICATION IS SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION WITH YOUR CLUB LEADER(S) AND THE EXTENSION OFFICE RECORDS. REPORTED TOTALS WILL BE CHECKED FOR ACCURACY. MAXIMUM OF 60 POINTS.**
