

Saunders County 4-H Catch-An-Animal Project- 2024

The Catch-An-Animal project is designed to give youth a low cost, practical experience raising an animal then showing it at the Saunders County Fair.

<u>Sign up:</u> Non-refundable \$50 deposit at time of sign up. The deposit will go towards the cost of the animal. Animals are reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis (your spot is not reserved until \$50 deposit is received).

Available animals and cost: Lambs (\$500-\$700 depending on how many sign up)

Educational Components: Each must be completed, failure to complete will result in ineligibility.

- Introduction, Feeding & Care with accompanying test— (ONLINE VIDEO). Required for new participants only.
- Picture of animal housing facility. Required for new participants.
- Showmanship & Fitting Opportunity.
- Producer Form Provides an update on the animals progress.
- Record book to be completed and turned in at fair.
- Interview about project at fair.

Catch-An-Animal exhibitors are eligible to sell 2 animals on the auction at fair. One market animal and one catch-an-animal. The catch-an-animal MUST meet weight criteria for sale.
