- The limit is a TOTAL of FIVE unique (static) entries per Clover Kid member.
- Clover Kid (static) exhibits are NOT eligible for any other county competition and are NOT eligible for State Fair.

- Exhibitors show in a non-competitive setting for participation only.
- Clover Kid exhibitors are required to complete the Saunders County Fair Online Pre-Entry" July 1 DEADLINE. The form will include exhibitor name and species.
- Clover Kids may exhibit in BOTH the Clover Kid Showmanship classes and the Saturday Clover Kid Animal Show. Pre-Entry by July 1<sup>st</sup> is required.
- Clover Kids exhibiting may stop by the 4-H Fairgrounds
  Office to pick up their 4-H shirt to be worn during the show.

  EXHIBITORS" for full dress code details.

### CLOVER KID ANIMAL EXHIBITING GUIDELINES

- Exhibition will consist of judge's discussions with youth based on their knowledge of the care and raising of the animal
- Age, size, and temperament of animal projects must be appropriate for the exhibitor's age and size.
  - FOR Beef Calf, Dairy Calf, Goat (Meat or Dairy), and Sheep: Clover Kid animal exhibits are to be no more than six months of age and no more than 350 pounds at time of show.
- The adult/teen volunteer to child ratio during the Clover Kid class will be 1:1 (i.e.: There will be ONE adult/teen volunteer present for every ONE Clover Kid exhibitor who is handling or exhibiting animals.)
- If the animal exhibited by the Clover Kid 4-H member is also exhibited by a 4-H/ FFA member (8–18 years old), the animal MUST abide by the guidelines within the (species) department/division.
- Horse Rules per Nebraska 4-H: Horse projects and/or horseless projects are not allowed or an option for Clover Kids. They are not allowed to handle, ride or participate in or at 4-H events.

### DIVISION 910 – CLOVER KID SATURDAY ANIMAL SHOW

## SATURDAY CLOVER KID ANIMAL SHOW RULES:
