Any youth wishing to compete at the Saunders County Fair Horse Show and/or State horse shows must complete the following paperwork and meet the following deadlines:

- **STATE HORSE SHOW:**
 - **ENROLLMENT-** 4-H Enrollment website can be found here <https://go.unl.edu/ctmy>
 - Any 4-H Member entering in **STATE CONTESTS** must enroll/re-enroll in 4-H by **June 1** through 4-H Online.
 - **ID PAPERS-** 4-H Member entering in **STATE CONTESTS** must submit 4-H Horse Project ID Affidavit **by June 1** to the Extension office. This form qualifies the horse to show at the State Horse show and the Saunders County Fair. ID Affidavit can be found here <https://go.unl.edu/5ni5>
 - If you plan on entering the 2- & 3-year-old Western Pleasure, you must fill out and return the 2 & 3-year-old Western Pleasure Affidavits to the Extension office by **June 1**. Affidavits can be found here: <https://go.unl.edu/35d3>
 - **ENTRY Requirements-** Complete entries ONLINE by June 1. Entries can be found here <https://4h.unl.edu/horse-expo>
 - **LEVEL TESTING-** Level testing information can be found here: <https://4h.unl.edu/horse/advancement>
 - All youth showing at **STATE CONTESTS** must complete 4-H Horsemanship Level testing by **June 1**. **See Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide for state requirements for class levels. HORSES USED FOR LEVELS TESTING MUST HAVE AN ID AFFIDAVIT FOR MEMBER FOR CURRENT YEAR.**
- **SAUNDERS COUNTY FAIR:**
 - **ENROLLMENT-** 4-H Enrollment information can be found here <https://go.unl.edu/ctmy>. Any 4-H Member only entering the **SAUNDERS COUNTY FAIR** must enroll/re-enroll in 4-H by **JUNE 15** through 4-H Online.



- **ID PAPERS**-Any 4-H Member only entering the **SAUNDERS COUNTY FAIR** contest must submit 4-H Horse Project ID Affidavit by **JUNE 15** to the Extension office. THIS IS THE FINAL DEADLINE FOR ID PAPERS FOR COUNTY FAIR. ID Affidavit can be found here <https://go.unl.edu/5ni5>
 - If you plan on entering 2- & 3-year-old Western Pleasure at fair, you must fill out and return the 2- & 3-year-old Western Pleasure affidavit and return to Extension office by July 1. <https://go.unl.edu/35d3>

- **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS-**
 - To be eligible to show at the Saunders County Fair, online pre-entry will be due **JULY 1. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED!**

 - Any 4-H Member only wishing to enter the **SAUNDERS COUNTY FAIR**, all 4-H Horsemanship Level testing must be completed and turned into the Saunders County Extension Office by **July 1. HORSES USED FOR LEVELS TESTING MUST HAVE AN ID AFFIDAVIT FOR MEMBER FOR CURRENT YEAR.**
 - All Horse exhibitors will be required to have passed Level I testing. *Exceptions include Walk- Trot and halter classes.* Some classes require passing Level II to compete in those classes at County Fair. Please see fair book for specific classes.
