



Garden and Morrill County youth participated in the STEMcares program during summer school programs. Teen program instructors gained valuable experiences with youth while local program directors enjoyed the STEM experiences for participants. “Having them come has been a huge success. The kids come faithfully to work on projects and crafts with the teen teachers. The teens were ready to go every time they came, and kept the kids engaged,” reported Crystal Thelander, program director of the Garden County 21st Century Learning Center, CHAMPS. 108 youth have benefited from the STEMcares programs.

Programs At-A-Glance
