2023 4-H CLUB CONTEST

Seward County Fair

Barn Quilts

- The Seward County 4-H Council and the Seward County Agricultural Society are pleased to announce that the club contest for 2023 is barn quilts.
- Signs will be hung at the fairgrounds. Ideas for designs are available at the Extension Office.
- Plywood panels may be picked up at the Seward County Extension Office after May 31.
- To register, call or email the office by May 25
- All entries will be used as fair decoration throughout the grounds.
- Please have quilts ready by **Wednesday, August 2, 2023.** They can be dropped off at the 4-H Center during clean-up night.

Supplies (supplied by Fairboard):

- The Ag Society will provide one piece of plywood 44" x 48 x 1/2". The actual design of the quilt will be 44" x 44" (the bottom four inches of the sign will be reserved for a club name plate.
- Primer will be provided, but will need to be applied by the club. Please return when finished with it.

Supplies (supplied by 4-H club):

Each group will provide their own paint and painting supplies. o Two coats of **exterior paint** painted on all sides (including edges) o High gloss or semi-gloss finish exterior sealant. o Do not use craft paints.

Design:

- The pattern must be a clean design, typical quilt appearance.
- Designs need to be submitted to the Extension Office for approval (prior to being painted) to ensure that there are no duplicate designs.
- Quilts will be judged and receive ribbon placings and special awards given.



We look forward to seeing your club's barn quilt this year!

Basic Barn Quilt Instructions:

General Instructions:

1. Use wood filler on any imperfections, especially on the cut edges. Lightly sand, if necessary.

2. Two coats of exterior primer on all sides (including edges).

3. Two coats of exterior paint in base color on all sides (including edges)

4. Mark off a 4" x 44" strip on the long end for the club name sign.

5. Paint your design in the 44" x 44" area.

6. Seal with a clear exterior sealant on all six sides.

1) **Choose** a simple quilt square pattern by looking at books or online. Search online for inspiration for barn quilt designs or fabric quilt designs. Designs must be approved before being painted to avoid duplicates.

2) Prep your wood – use wood filler on imperfections and sand wood to make sure it is smooth.

3) Prime your wood – let dry and apply a second coat. Let dry again before painting.

4) Paint two coats of exterior paint in base color on all sides (including edges).

5) **Sketch** a grid onto your plywood with the same number of squares as the quilt block. Quilt blocks are usually 3x3 or 4x4 grids. Use a measuring tape and a straightedge to draw the right size grid onto your plywood

a. One way to make sure that your gridlines are at right angles is to use a piece of printer paper to check the corner.

b. An easy way to find the center of your board is to draw 2 diagonal lines across connecting the corners. The point where the lines cross is the center.

6) Transfer your **design** onto the board in pencil. Match up lines on the quilt block with the grid squares on your plywood to help you enlarge the pattern. Use a ruler or another form of straightedge to help you draw straight lines

7) Label each section with its color.

8) Put painter's tape around the sections for your lightest color. Apply painter's tape in a straight line along each edge of the sections where you will paint your lightest color. The inner edge of the painter's tape should be lined up with the pencil outline of that color. It's best to start with your lightest color and work your way up to the darker colors.

9) **Paint 2 coats of paint in the taped off sections.** Use **exterior latex paint**. Paint inside the tape lines for all the sections that are in your first color. You can use a paintbrush, a paint roller, or even a makeup sponge to apply the paint. Paint right up to the tape line and a little bit on top of the tape.

10) Remove tape and allow first color to dry completely.

11) Continue taping and painting until you've finished the pattern. Remember to be patient and let each paint color dry thoroughly before moving onto the next color. Use a fresh paintbrush for each color.

12) **Touch up mistakes with an artist's paintbrush.** There will probably be a few small spots where one color accidentally bled over onto the other color. Using a small artist's paintbrush, cover up the mistakes with a little bit of the correct color.

13) Seal with a clear exterior varnish or polyurethane.

The 4-H Culinary Challenge Contest will require youth to demonstrate healthy decision making through nutrition, food preparation, menu planning, and food safety, utilizing foods and nutrition curriculum. They will apply healthy living knowledge and skills by planning a nutritious menu, demonstrating their understanding of time management skills in the kitchen, and expressing their originality and creativity through an appropriately themed and properly set table. To showcase these skills, youth will:

- ♦ Create a menu.
- Prepare one food item using the challenge ingredient. The 2023 challenge ingredient is **sunflower**.
- Choose an appropriate theme for their occasion while expressing their food, nutrition, and food safety knowledge during a live interview with a judge at the contest.
- Utilize technology as part of their interview in order to highlight knowledge and skills acquired during precontest preparation.



YOUTH REQUALITY CARE RANIMALS

All livestock, rabbit, and poultry exhibitors: read entire contents to be sure you know how to complete your YQCA Certification.

All livestock, rabbit, and poultry exhibitors must pass YQCA yearly to be eligible to exhibit at the Seward County Fair and NE State Fair shows. Youth may enroll in online classes or attend a trainer-led class. Please contact Cindy at the Extension Office if you have any questions.
