Each exhibitor can show up to two horses in 4-H and two horses in FFA <u>but only one horse per class/event</u>. A single horse **may not** be entered or ridden in a class or event by more than one person even though the horse is jointly owned by 2 or more members of the same family. For example: a person and a horse can enter only ONE Pleasure class. **You can ride as a 4-H member <u>OR</u> as an FFA member in each class/event. You <u>CAN NOT</u> have an entry in 4-H and FFA in the same class/event.** 

4-H horse exhibitors that participate in the horse show at county fair must pass the Horse Level 1 test before July 1. If you can't control your horse, the judge has a right to disqualify exhibitor.
