Poultry will be cared for during the fair by the exhibitor. A trio entry is one cockerel and two pullets. Birds entered as single exhibits are not eligible for trio. All poultry exhibitors need to be present during the judging of the show. Poultry will be cared for by 4-H or FFA exhibitor. There is no limit on the number of entries each exhibitor can show in Poultry. Bantams must be 4-month-old and full size must be 6 months old. All classes must state breed and sex.
