

RABBITS (DEPARTMENT G)

Only purple ribbon rabbits are eligible for championship awards.

Rabbit Show - 4 p.m. Thursday, August 1

Entry time - 7-9 a.m., Thursday, August 1

Purple \$4 Blue \$3 Red \$2

All rabbit exhibitors are required to take YQCA Training to exhibit at the fair.

Dress code - see page 3.

Preregistration due by July 8.

There is no limit on the number of entries an exhibitor can show in Rabbits. No rabbit may show in both a Meat and Commercial Class. The rabbits must be shown by a 4-H or FFA exhibitor.

Each exhibitor must provide their own feed and water bowls. Market rabbits will only be weighed at registration. **Rabbits must be tattooed by June 1.** Pre-registration will be required. Any rabbit incorrectly entered will be lowered a ribbon placing.

The 4-H rabbit project manual which explains the rules for the different classes is available through the County Extension Office.
