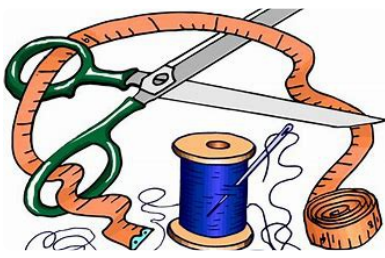

In 2025, 4-H Council is sponsoring Blooms in a Bucket. One-gallon buckets can be picked up from the Extension Office and must be planted with real flowers. This is open to the public so 4-H'ers invite moms, dads, grandparents, friends and neighbors to join in the fun. Buckets will be judged in these age divisions: Youth, ages 5-18, Adult, 19-59, Senior, 60+. Prizes will be awarded for each age division - 1st place \$20 and 2nd place \$10. More details to come.
