

2021 Hayes & Hitchcock Shooting Sports Dates

- Nebraska Extension and the 4-H shooting sports instructors' first priority is safety. Firearm safety as well as health safety due to COVID-19. It is not required but encouraged that participants continue social distancing, use of hand sanitizer, hand washing and masks. Please if you are feeling ill, do not participate or attend the practices or contests.
- To keep everyone safe and teach youth to handle the equipment properly instructors may need to be less than 6 feet from the youth. If you are not comfortable with this, please talk to one of the shooting sports instructors before practice or contest.
- **Please provide your own EAR and EYE protection.**
- All ***4-H exhibitors must attend TWO practices*** per discipline to be eligible to compete at the county contests.
- All youth members must be present on time to set up and help with cleanup for practices to count.
- **Youth must sign out at practice with instructor to receive credit for the practice.** If youth do not sign out, youth will NOT receive credit for attending practice.
- Youth must have completed the Firearm Hunter Education Course and present a card to participate in Muzzleloader, Pistol and Smallbore (.22 Rifle) Projects.

Trap/Sporting Clays

Due to lack of availability of shotgun shells and no club inventory to supply youth there will be no Trap this year unless supply becomes available at later date.

1st & 2nd year Archery Participants

This practice is **only for 1st and 2nd year archery participants.** Older youth may attend but will be expected to assist with younger youth. If older youth attends and assists in teaching younger youth it will count as a practice.
