Division 908 – Range Board Display - All Range Boards shall be 36" x 36" & 3/8" thick. Mounted range plants must be on the list of important range in the current Nebraska Range Judging Handbook. Mounted range plants must include roots, stem, and head. The Board shall not be covered by a plastic material. The exhibit must show the name of the exhibitor, chapter, and each range plant shall be identified as follows: common name, scientific name, forage value, season of growth, and life span. Display Boards should have at least 15 range plants.
