4-H Achievement Application (4-H Record Books)

The 4-H Achievement Application is used each year to recognize 4-H'ers with 4-H awards for their accomplishments in 4-H. The applications are judged on growth in 4-H projects, leadership and citizenship in 4-H and community.

Please use the following format. There is not specific form as in the past years. It is more of an essay or 4-H story with the option of adding photos or infographics.

- Length limit to applications are 3 pages for Juniors (4-H age 8-14) and 4 pages for Seniors (4-H age 15 18).
- Use headings to separate your responses (4-H Experiences, Leadership Experiences, Community Involvement/Service Learning Experiences, and Career Spark). P
- Place 4-H Achievement Applications in Green 4-H Record Book Covers.
- Keep all past year's record books in green record book cover.
- Creativity is encouraged, use bullet lists, photos, infographics, etc. to help tell your 4-H story. The items bulleted are suggestions of what might help us understand your involvement and learning.
