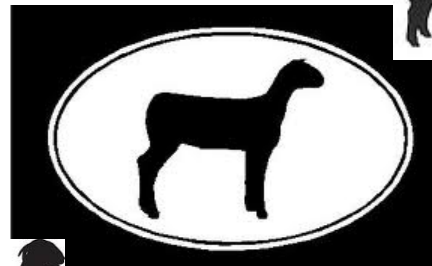

Rules and Regulations on Back!

2016 Rules and Regulations

General Show Information:

This show is open to all 4-H and FFA members. Exhibitors must be 8 years old by January 1st and have not passed their 21st birthday by January 1st of the current year. Livestock may be brought in after 7:30 a.m. on Saturday June 18th. The Show Committee will have the final decision on class breaks and registration paper discrepancies. **Please bring your own bedding if necessary; you are responsible for clean up.**

Dress: 4-H/FFA shirts **ARE** required. **NO** halter-tops or sleeveless shirts/blouses.

Swine Show Information:

Attention: For the protection of all swine exhibitors please do **NOT** bring any pigs that have shown clinical signs of disease within the last 60 days.

Showmanship: Senior Division: 16 and older as of January 1, 2016
Intermediate Division: 12-15 as of January 1, 2016
Junior Division: 8-11 as of January 1, 2016

Market and Breeding: All Swine **MUST** have a current Nebraska 4-H or FFA ear tag in place, or identified by the Universal ear notch system in both ears to be eligible to show.

Breeding Gilts: All breeding gilts **MUST** be born after December 1, 2015
Breeds if 3 or more entered in division; Registration papers must be presented at check-in.
Gilts without papers will show in the crossbred class.

Market Swine: Open to barrows and gilts; they will be shown together. Classes will be set by weight, which may be declared by exhibitor. Show committee reserves the right to re-weigh any animal.
Disqualification may result if such animal exceeds declared weight by more than 5%.
Breeds if 3 head or more entered in division; Registration papers must be presented at check-in.

Show Order: Showmanship, Breeding Gilts, and Market Swine

Meat Goat and Sheep Show Information:

Showmanship: Senior Division: 16 and older as of January 1, 2016
Intermediate Division: 12-15 as of January 1, 2016
Junior Division: 8-11 as of January 1, 2016

Breeding Goats: Yearling does must be born 9/1/2014 to 8/31/2015. Doe kids must be born after 9/1/2015. Classes will be divided by age.

Meat Goats: All meat goats must have a 4-H or FFA identification tag. Meat goats will be shown by weight. No re-weighs.

Goats are to have milk teeth and there shall be no evidence of breaking of the skin or eruption of the two permanent front teeth.

Goats must have horns blunted.

Goats are to be shown with neck chains or smooth collars only.

Market goats may be doe or wether kids. Short scrotum, cyptorchid and buck kids are not eligible. Does and wethers will show together. No Dairy Goats.

Breeding Ewes: Ewe lambs must be born after 9/1/2015. Yearling ewes must be born 9/1/2014 to 8/31/2015. Classes will be divided by breeds. All registration papers **MUST** be presented at check-in. Ewes without papers will show in the crossbred class.

Market Lambs: All market lambs **MUST** have a 4-H or FFA identification tag. Market lambs will be shown by weight. No re-weighs.

Goat Show Order: Showmanship, Breeding Does, and Meat Goats
Showmanship, Breeding Sheep, and Market Lambs

***Pee Wee classes if enough show interest for all three species.
