



NEW REQUIREMENT: ID PHOTO VERIFICATION FORM

To ensure all families are meeting the requirements of properly identifying their 4-H animals by the June 15 deadline, completion of a **ID Photo Verification** form must be completed per household, per species by June 15.

ALL animals listed on a livestock ID sheet and entered into the Washington County Fair as a 4-H Livestock Project must have an image *with the placed ear tag* uploaded into this **ID PHOTO VERIFICATION FORM** for the 4-H member to qualify for entry at the Washington County Fair.

COMMON QUESTIONS, ANSWERED:

What is the ID Photo Verification form?

An online upload of pictures verifying the proper tagging of livestock animals as it relates to the June 15 identification deadline.

Who is this new requirement for?

All 4-H members exhibiting a beef, goat, sheep or hog project at the Washington County Fair.

How do I complete this requirement?

What if I can't complete the form online?

4-H families have the option to turn-in printed photos (attached to corresponding ID sheets) to meet this requirement by bringing them to the office. Emailed files will not be accepted.

STEPS TO COMPLETE PHOTO VERIFICATION:

1. Access the photo verification form here: <https://go.unl.edu/wcphotoid>
2. Click the purple "NEW" button at the top left corner. This may also show up as 3 dots if you're on a mobile device.
3. Complete the form as guided; listing your HOUSEHOLD name, selecting the animal type represented in the photos being uploaded, etc.
 - a. If completing from a computer, you will have to hold "CTRL" to select multiple photos. Otherwise only one will be included in your submission.
 - b. Please only create ONE submission per animal species per household.
4. Once you have completed the form and selected the corresponding photos, click the SAVE button.
 - a. Please be aware that saving times vary depending on number of photos included in upload and size of file. Be patient and do not refresh your browser.
5. To ensure your upload was saved correctly, find your household name in the uploaded files list and click to see the content added.

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS:

- Photo has animal's head centered in view.
- Ear tag with visible tag number clearly seen and readable.
 - "visible tag number" is 4-digits
- Photo is not blurry.
- Photo is in color.

EDITING ENTRIES:

Uploaders can re-enter the system to edit a previous entry.

1. When in system, simply click on YOUR HOUSEHOLD NAME and select "Edit" from the options shown in the "... " menu area.
2. Make edits and click "save" before exiting.
