Each event must have **five** 4-Hers registered to be held and is limited to **ten** participants per session (Table Runner Workshop is limited to **eight**, Watercolor Painting Workshop must have **ten** registered, with a maximum of **sixteen**). *Workshop limits are based on the order of participant registry.*

Workshops may be cancelled or held virtually depending on Directive Health Measures that are in place at the time of the workshop.

Watercolor Painting Workshop (NEW)

Location: Virtual, via Zoom

Date & Time: June 17, 9 AM – 12 Noon

Recommended: Youth enrolled in Portfolio Pathways-exhibited in class: +C-261-003 Original Watercolor

Cost: \$15

Registration Due: June 10 (minimum of ten registered to be held with a maximum of sixteen)

Description: Youth will learn painting techniques and create a project that can be exhibited as an original acrylic painting. Workshop instructed by Connie Buskohl of Let's Paint Run-A-Ways.

Materials Needed: Watercolor Markers (like Crayola Super Tips Watercolor) Markers (washable) or Watercolor Paints, One (1) fine tipped permanent marker (Sharpie or other brand), any small soft brush. Watercolor paper will be provided if needed.

Date & Time: June 30, 9 AM– 3 PM

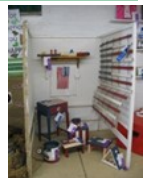

Table Runner Workshop

Location: Meeting Room, Wayne County Courthouse

Date & Time: July 10, Session 1: 9 AM– Noon **OR** Session 2: 1-4 PM

Recommended: Youth enrolled in Design My Place-exhibited in class C-251-902 Simple Fabric Accessory OR Design Decisions-exhibited in class: +C-257-010 Accessory-Textile-2D



Cost: \$5

Registration Due: July 2 (limit of 8 per session)

Description: Youth will learn beginning sewing techniques and create a simple table runner.

Additional Information: Please bring 10 inch piece of 44/45 inch width fabric (1/4 yard) for the center and a 20 inch piece of the 44/45 inch width fabric (1/2 yard) for the border and back. All fabric is 100% cotton that is randomly printed, not a fabric with a specific pattern or direction. Prewash & press fabric prior to the workshop. Optional: two coordinating buttons to embellish the table runner, a spool of coordinating thread, a mat, and rotary cutter.
