4-H COW/CALF PROJECT REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE WAYNE COUNTY FAIR COW/CALF SHOW

AGE OF EXHIBITORS

4-H members may be certified to exhibit at the Wayne County Fair when they meet the age requirements for the event and have properly enrolled in the project at the Wayne County Extension Office.

OWNERSHIP

All cow/calf pairs must be owned by the exhibitor. Joint ownership is permissible for the purpose of owning, caring for and keeping records on animals belonging to 4-H members within the immediate family. Immediate family is defined as members of a household, including parents, brothers and sisters, and youth in the care of the head of the household.

CERTIFICATION FOR THE WAYNE COUNTY FAIR COW/CALF SHOW

All 4-H cow/calf pairs to be exhibited at the Wayne County Fair must be certified on the Wayne County 4-H Cow/Calf Ownership Affidavit, and submitted to the Wayne County Extension Office by June 15 of the current year or earlier.

IDENTIFICATION

Exhibitor must have copy of affidavit in hand at the Wayne County Fair.

INCENTIVES FOR SHOWING HOME RAISED OR COUNTY RAISED 4-H BEEF

4-H Beef shown at the Wayne County Fair will receive an increased premium if animals are home raised or county raised. An animal may be identified as **Home Raised** if it was born and raised by the 4-H member or his /her immediate family on their place of residence. **County Raised** animals are identified as those born in Wayne County and purchased from a Wayne County producer. County or home raised cows that were shown at the previous year's Wayne County Fair as a breeding heifer and returning to this year's fair as part of a cow/calf pair are eligible for an additional premium. HR (home raised), CR (county raised) and R (returning with previous years project) must be indicated on the Wayne County 4-H Cow/Calf Ownership Affidavit to receive additional premiums.

RENEE'S HERD BUILDER CLASS
