



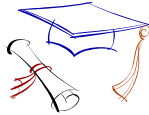

## ID FORM (AFFIDAVIT) REMINDER



**ID Forms (Affidavits)** for Dairy; Dairy and Pygmy Goats; Breeding Beef; Cow/Calf Pairs; Feeder Calf; Rabbits; and Ak-Sar-Ben/State Fair Meat Goats, Sheep and Swine are due **June 15**. It is your responsibility to make sure these forms are accurate. All necessary data must be present and correct. **If ID forms are faxed to the office to meet the deadline, the original must be in the office the following business day.** All ID papers are available for download at <http://wayne.unl.edu/web/wayne/4hanimalaffidavits> and at the Extension Office.

**New for 2015:** All animals (except Dairy and Horse) must complete an on-line affidavit to be eligible for State Fair and Ak-Sar-Ben by midnight June 15. Hard copies are still required for county fair. We will work with the families this affects. Instructions can be found on the Wayne County web page.

In addition, breeding animal registration papers and **British breed steer** registration papers are due to the Extension Office by **5 p.m., June 15** and we will forward them to the State 4-H Office. Also, as a reminder youth will be **REQUIRED** to present the **ORIGINAL** copies of the registration papers, even though they have submitted photo copies in advance. Original registration papers or electronic papers presented using a tablet or smart phone will be accepted during check in at the State Fair if pulled up or downloaded from their respective breed website. **NO PRINTED PAPER COPIES ACCEPTED.** Original papers or electronic versions only.

No study materials are to be used while taking the test. The contest will allow an opportunity for the participant to review the answers prior to submitting. Once submitted, the participants will see their score, but they will not be able to see which questions they missed. After the contest has ended, the participants can request to see their scores and their answers.

Capture editorial photos that tell a story about your Nebraska Community.

### UNIT III Nebraska Photography Career Exhibit

**Print:** Explore a career as a commercial photographer. Commercial photographers take pictures that are used for promotional purposes. Commercial photographs are often used in print and online communication materials (advertisements, brochures, flyers, web sites, social media banners, direct email messages, etc.). Capture commercial photos that tell the story of 4-H in your Nebraska community; photos should show the Nebraska 4-H Program in action. Photos may be used to promote the UNL Extension 4-H Youth Development Program.
