



WEBSTER COUNTY

Ninety-seven percent of the youth in Webster County participated in [Webster County After School Programs](#) held in three locations in 2017. Youth gained knowledge regarding all aspects of 4-H and participated in hands-on activities and learning experiences. As a result, **33%** of youth enrolled in Webster County public schools are currently enrolled in 4-H.

[Farmers and Ranchers Cow/Calf College – Partners in Progress Beef Seminar](#) had an attendance of 101 college students, educators, agribusiness professionals, and beef producers. The number of cattle managed by the attendees was over **8,500 head**, with over **20,700 acres of ranchland/pasture**, over **3,700 acres of hayland**, and over **29,000 acres of cropland**. The information presented in the program allowed producers to predict a savings of over **\$19/head**.

Sixty-four youth participated in 4-H camps throughout the summer of 2017. This included **31 youth** at the Clover Kid Camp held at the Fairgrounds in Bladen. These youth each made 5 different exhibits to be entered into the fair over the course of the program.

Thirty-three 4-H youth attended the Explore the Outdoors day camp at Liberty Cove for a day full of outdoor science exploration activities. This included learning about wind energy, solar power, fishing, summer safety, animal rescue, and entrepreneurship opportunities.
