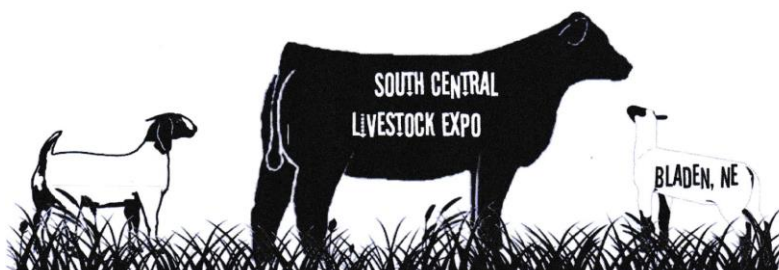

# 2022 SOUTH CENTRAL LIVESTOCK EXPOSITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is open to all current 4-H and FFA members who are in good standing within their state. They must be at least 8 years old and not older than 21 years by January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year and **must show their own animals**.
2. Beef exhibits will be accepted until 8:00 am, Saturday morning, June 4, and must be on the grounds and checked in and weighed prior to that time. All sheep and goats must be in place before 10:00 am on June 4. **No beef entries will be accepted after 8:00 am, June 4 and no sheep or goat entries after 10:00 am on June 4.**
4. All entries, except for breeding stock, must have a current FFA or 4-H tag and/or Nebraska EID tag.
5. **Beef will each have two divisions; Breeding and Market.** Breeding Heifers will be shown by breeds and age and must be born between 9/1/20 & 12/31/21. All registration papers must be presented at check-in. Heifers without papers will show in the commercial class. All breeding heifers must be identified by legible ear tattoo(s). There must be at least three breeding heifers of one breed to constitute a breed class, or heifers may be shown in either British or Commercial class.
6. **Market steers will be weighed, and classes will be broken according to breed and weight.** British Breed steers will need registration papers or breed affidavit plus 4-H/FFA tag. All non-registered or non-papered British and all Crossbred Steers will show in the Continental Breed Class. Market heifers will be shown by weight.
7. **Sheep and meat goats will each have two divisions; Breeding and Market.** Breeding classes will be grouped by age; market animals grouped by weight. Ewe lambs and doe kids must be born after 9/1/2021. Yearling ewes and does must be born 9/1/2020 to 8/31/2021. Aged ewes and does must be born before 8/31/2020. All registration papers must be presented at check-in. Ewes without papers will show in the commercial class. All female sheep and goats must have a scrapie tag and either tattoo and/or 4-H/FFA ID tag.
8. Early entry fee of \$30.00 per beef entry and \$15.00 per sheep or goat entry will be assessed if registrations are received by June 3. Webster County 4-H and FFA exhibitor early entry fees will be \$20 for beef and \$12 for sheep and goats. Exhibitors may register on the day of the show with entry fees of \$35 for beef and \$17 for sheep and goats. Webster County exhibitors show day fees will be \$25 for beef and \$14 for sheep and goats. Fees can be sent with early registration or may be paid on site on June 4. Make checks payable to: **Webster County Junior Leaders.**
9. **Showmanship classes in each species will be broke down according to exhibitor's age** as of January 1, 2022. Showmanship classes will consist of: Junior division; 13 and under, and Senior division; 14 and older.
10. All exhibits will receive ribbons, top exhibits cash. The South Central Livestock Exposition management reserves the right to award trophies or rosettes and cash awards dependent upon exhibit quality and number of animals in the class.
11. **All exhibits are asked to be housed in their respective barns. ABSOLUTELY NO HAY OR FEED IS ALLOWED IN THE BEEF BARNs.** Please feed your beef outside of beef barns. **All exhibitors will need to furnish their own bedding.** Exhibitors are reminded that they must clean their pens and put the bedding at the pit west of the beef and swine barns at the conclusion of the show!!!
12. All 4-H and FFA members are encouraged to wear appropriate 4-H or FFA dress, (T-shirts are recommended) and are encouraged to wear leather shoes or boots while exhibiting their livestock. **NOTE: Showmanship placing may reflect the neglect of either one of these encouraged practices.**
13. **ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO FIT THEIR OWN ANIMALS.** Only family members, fellow club, or chapter members, FFA advisor, or 4-H club leader may assist the exhibitor. The Expo management expects all exhibitors to follow the Quality Assurance Guidelines for Livestock and the Code of Livestock Ethics as outlined by the IAFE.
14. A lunch stand will be available for your convenience.
15. Exhibitors and visitors please take notice that the Webster County Fair Board, UNL, Nebraska Extension, and Livestock Exposition Management **WILL NOT BE LIABLE** for any damage, loss, or accidents that may occur to any participants, his or her exhibit or personal property.
