

WEBSTER COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

Persons wishing to apply for this scholarship provided by the Webster County Youth Council must fill out an application form available at their school or the Webster County Extension Office.

Selection will be made by a committee composed of two youth and two adult council members and a representative of the Webster County Extension staff. All members of the committee will have no personal interest in the applicants. If they do, a substitute will be appointed by remaining members.

All applicants will be ranked as a winner or designated alternate. The winners will receive the scholarship the second semester of the college year upon receipt of proof of enrollment to UNL Extension -Webster County for the second semester.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Scholarship applications must be in the Webster County Extension Office by April 1, 2021.

2. Applicants must:

- a. Be a high school senior or high school graduate with sufficient credits for college entrance.
- b. Be or have been a member of a Webster County 4-H Club a minimum of three years and successfully completed a minimum of one year's club work.
- c. Enroll in a two or four year college or University.
- d. Provide two letters of recommendation certifying:
 - (a) Character (c) Leadership Qualities
 - (b) Ideals (d) Basis of Need

One of the letters should be from a school faculty member or administration and the second letter should come from a community member that is not a relative and is not associated with school. Recommendations should be provided by persons who have known applicant over a long period to be qualified to provide reasonably accurate information on the above criteria.

Letters of recommendation are to be mailed or delivered by the writer to UNL Extension - Webster County, Red Cloud, NE by the date scholarship applications are due.

(Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant to ascertain that letters of recommendation have been sent in by the date they are due. The scholarship committee will not consider applicants if letters of recommendation have not been received.)

3. Winners will be determined by a scoring system that emphasizes: (1) Scholarship, (2) Leadership, (3) 4-H Club Work and Activities.
